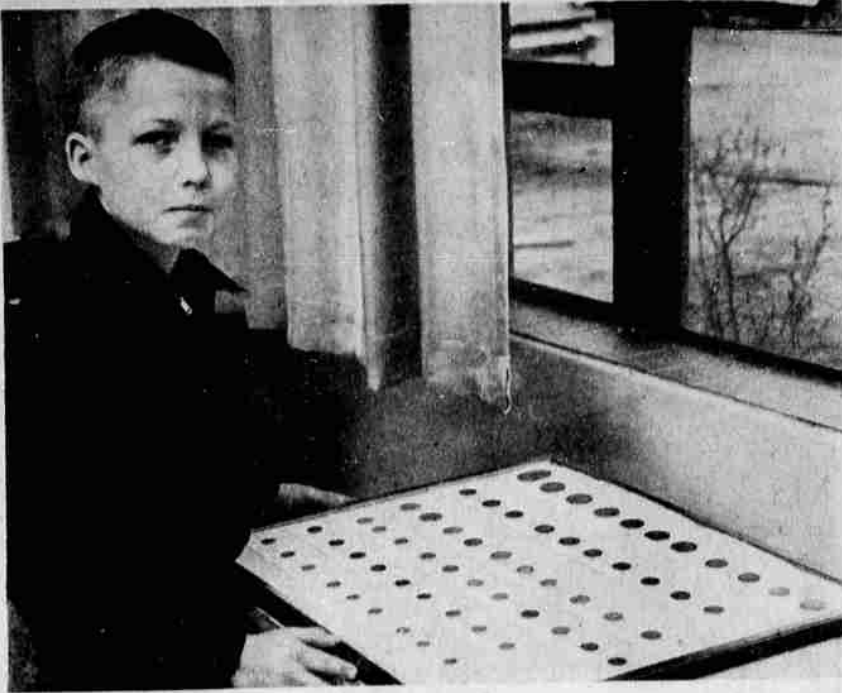

"One of the chief concerns for the church in 1956 should be fostering and intelligent public study and discussion of the problem," he continued.

O & C Timber Fires Listed

PORTLAND — Thirty-seven fires burned 3,000 acres of O & C forest lands in 1954, causing an estimated damage of \$530,000, Bureau of Land Management officials said Wednesday.

However, salvage of the fire-killed timber will make up most of the damage, said Virgil T. Heath, BLM supervisor for Oregon.

Lightning set 19 of the fires and 18 were man-caused, nine of them in lumbering operations. Two of the largest fires of the season were started by broken power lines.

In 1954, there were 21 fires in BLM forest districts, burning 174 acres and causing \$1,800 damage. John C. Hunt, BLM fire control officer, said the number of fires in the five grazing districts of Eastern Oregon was reduced from 81 in 1954 to 77 last year. The BLM protects approximately 20 million acres of range, woodland and scattered forest land east of the Cascades.
