FAMILY FAVORITE

Take a poll among the family on favorite foods, and you'll probably find that smooth, creamy peanut butter ranks right up with the top choices. Certainly, if peanut butter is popular with your family, you'll enjoy trying new and different ways of using it.

Baking with peanut butter isn't exactly new, but if you haven't tried it before, you'll boast of a real discovery when you do. Peanut butter cookies help fill that ever diminishing cookie jar, and they're easy to make, too. Of course, it's always important that you select a quality peanut butter that is creamy and has a captivating flavor. This fine branded peanut butter is perfect for your best baking.

Something a bit different along the cookie line is this recipe in which the cookie dough is formed into small balls and placed on the cookie sheet. You then can flatten the cookie slightly or make a deep hole in the center for a cookie garnish.

This party-style recipe features a crisp plain peanut butter cookie topped with a spoonful of colorful jam which adds a gala note. Children will love this cookie, and grown-ups will have their share, too. You'll find that peanut butter cookies keep well. Just store them in a loosely covered container to keep them crisp and chewy.

PEANUT BUTTER JELLY CRUNCHIES
(Yield: 2½ dozen 3-inch cookies)
1½ cup shortening
1 cup granulated sugar
1 cup brown sugar, packed
1 teaspoon vanilla
2 eggs
1½ cups sifted flour
1 teaspoon soda
3 cups rolled oats
1½ pound salted Spanish peanuts

Cream shortening and add sugar gradually. Add vanilla and continue creaming. Add eggs and beat well. Sift flour with soda and add. Stir in rolled oats and peanuts and blend thoroughly. Form dough with hands into small balls. Place on ungreased cookie sheet and flatten slightly. Bake in a hot oven (425 degrees) 7 to 10 minutes.

Cookies are a favorite, especially when they're made with that favorite breakfast cereal, raisin bran — the kind where the raisins have been dipped in honey and rolled in sugar.

BRAN FLAKES COOKIES
1½ cups sifted flour
1½ cups raisin bran
1½ cups sugar
1½ cups butter or other shortening
1 cup firmly packed brown sugar

Sift flour once, measure, add soda, salt and ginger, and sift again. Place molasses, butter, and sugar in saucepan and cook gently 2 minutes, stir constantly. Cool to lukewarm. Add cereal and mix well. Then add flour mixture and mix thoroughly. Chill until firm enough to roll. Roll ½ inch, thick on lightly floured board. Cut with assorted Christmas cookie cutters. Place on greased baking sheet and bake in moderate oven (350 degrees) 10 minutes. Outline edges of cookies with confectioners' sugar frosting, using a pastry tube. Makes about 2 dozen cookies.

SALTED PEANUT COOKIES
1½ cups sifted flour
1½ cups raisin bran
1½ cups sugar
1½ cups butter or other shortening
1 cup firmly packed brown sugar

Sift flour once, measure, add baking powder, soda and salt, and sift again. Cream shortening, add sugar gradually, and cream together until light and fluffy. Add egg and beat well. Add flour, alternately with milk, mixing well after each addition. Stir in cereal and peanuts. Drop by teaspoonfuls onto greased baking sheet. Bake in moderate oven (375 degrees) 8 minutes, or until done. Makes about 4 dozen cookies.

CHOCOLATE CHIP COOKIES
1 cup sifted flour
1½ teaspoons double-acting baking powder
1½ teaspoon salt
1½ cup butter or other shortening

Sift flour once, measure, add baking powder and salt, and sift again. Cream shortening, add sugar gradually, and cream together until light and fluffy. Add egg and beat well. Add flour, alternately with milk, beating after each addition. Add vanilla, cereal and semi-sweet chocolate chips and blend. Drop by teaspoonfuls onto greased baking sheet. Bake in moderate oven (375 degrees) 10 minutes, or until done. Makes about 4 dozen cookies.
