



NEW CARPET WEAVE, added qualities, designs and colors are introduced by James Lees and Sons Company this year. Here is shown an abstract pattern that gives a feeling of moving shadows across the ground. This new "Virginian" pattern by Lees provides a new floorward look for 1956. The jewel-like accents of ruby, turquoise and aqua appear against an amethyst beige ground.

FLOORS GET NEW LOOK

New weaves, exciting patterns and an array of textured contemporary designs are sprinkled with new colors for Spring '56 in the Lees carpet line. These range from nubby textures and modern abstracts to 18th Century brocades.

A distinctively flecked effect, aptly named, "Charcross," features an all over application of charcoal dabs against the ground color. The result is the appearance of casual texture, yet offering the practicality and versatility of plain cut pile carpet. This new quality is woven by a new Lees technique. "Charcross" ground green, sandalwood, ivory, aqua, mist, dove grey and shell beige, all in 12-foot widths. The carpet is made with face yarns of all-wool.

Another new Lees quality introduced for 1956 is a Wilton beauty called "Ovation." Styled for use with traditionally flavored contemporary furniture, "Ovation" features a graceful scroll design etched in high cut pile against a low relief of a flat ground. The result provides a plush, elegant carpet. It is all wool, made in 12 and 15-foot widths in these crystal tone shades of green, rose quartz, nutria, dove grey and aquagreen.

Four new designs give fresh influence to famous "Virginian" quality. One is a 19th Century Georgian style on an embossed Kashmir greige ground. Tan scrolls are scaled for moderately-sized interiors.

A rich 18th Century brocade of flowers and scrolls against a trio of beige, rose and antique black tones is another new "Virginian," while a third design features floral bouquets in golds, pinks, greens, blues and amethyst against a textured ground of ivory beige that is ideal for transitional furnishings.

An abstract pattern in contemporary feeling rounds out the new "Virginian" designs. This is like a series of moving shadows studied with accents of ruby, turquoise and aqua over an amethyst ground.

A lively flowing design, called Sand Swirls in "Iridescent" quality, is smoothly flowing, non-directional textured pattern. Pull down and regular all-wool yarns are dyed in two beautiful color

NEAR-EAST DESSERT WITH TURKISH COFFEE

Arabian Delight combines the subtle flavors of honey and almonds while Turkish Coffee presents the piping brew in an unusual and delicious way. Together, they'll make a conversation piece for your party and taste as attractive as they look, too.

ARABIAN DELIGHT

2 cups boiling water
Juice of 2 lemons
16 zwieback
1/2 cup canned chopped roasted almonds
1 cup honey
Frozen Whipped Cream (recipe follows)

Combine boiling water and lemon juice; pour over zwieback. Let stand until puffed and softened. Drain off liquid. Sprinkle half the almonds in bottom of 8-inch pie pan; add half the zwieback and top with half the honey. Add remaining zwieback and almonds. Bake in moderate oven, 325 degrees, 45 minutes. Cool slightly. Serve warm with cubes of Frozen Whipped Cream. Yield: 6 to 8 servings.

FROZEN WHIPPED CREAM
Beat 1 cup whipping cream until thick; add 1 tablespoon sugar and 1 teaspoon rum flavoring. Spoon into 7-inch square pan or freezing tray. Freeze until firm. Cut into squares to serve. Makes 6 to 8 servings.

TURKISH COFFEE

1 1/2 measuring cups water
3 tablespoons sugar
3 tablespoons finely ground coffee
Measure sugar and coffee into a heavy saucepan or an "ibrik." Stir over heat until it comes to a boil and is frothy. Remove from heat until froth subsides. Return to heat and repeat process twice.

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JIFFY DESSERT

Here is the sassiest dish since lamb chops showed up in booties—and handy, taste-tempting Coca-Cola forms the base. It looks like a school-boy's dream—and it is a hostess' delight because it can be tossed together in seconds with just the things anyone is likely to have on her pantry shelf or tucked in her "frig."

COKE ROYAL

A bucket of shaved ice
6 Bottles of Coca-Cola
1 Can ready whipped cream
1 Small bottle of cherries
Or 1 Small tin of crushed pineapple
1 Bar of unsweetened chocolate
Or several grated nuts
6 Short straws

Set out sherbet glasses on your loveliest tray before your guests arrive. When ready, slip shaved ice into the glasses 2-3 full. Then pour chilled Coca-Cola over the ice. Spray one of those ready whips over the top (or used heavy un-whipped cream if you wish the cream to float right into the Coke). Flick chopped chocolate over the whipped cream and set a cherry on top. Add a short straw (a big one cut in half) a sugar wafer... and serve.

For garnish variety: use crushed pineapple instead of the cherries or substitute shaved nuts for the chopped chocolate. If you are bent on drama give them everything... fruit, nuts, chocolate—and as much as will fit on the whipped cream topping.

Make a hit with your timid guests by setting out all the ingredients for "seconds" on the same tray on which you serve the dessert—so everyone can help herself to another round.

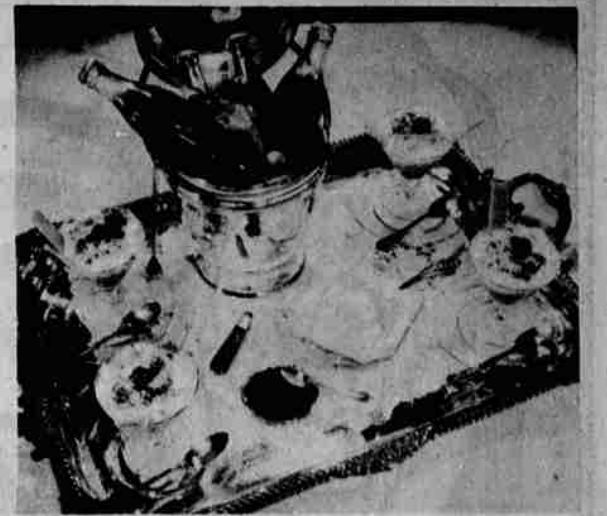
MEDICINE

If you have to give unpleasant-tasting medicine to one of the youngsters, give him a spoonful of crushed ice or several small pieces of ice to suck. The cold helps kill the bitterness.

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COKE ROYAL is a "lightnin' dessert" for those whose meal is not complete without a sweet. If your guests—or family—prefer a dessert without garnish and to double as a liqueur, pour a few drops of Creme de Cacao into the glass after the Coke has been poured over shaved ice. It is delicious and just the happy meal-ending for someone who doesn't want a creamy dessert.

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
