CHEMULT — Presence of mind and quick action on the part of George W. Perry, who operates the Richfield Service Station here, is credited with saving the life of Paul Breithaupt last Friday. Breithaupt, Poe Valley farmer, was driving through Chemult with a truck and trailer load of hay. He got to the service station about 2:30 a.m. and Perry noticed he appeared to be ill and shortly thereafter he fainted. Perry applied artificial respiration and called the help of Ralph Watson who called Jim Ayers, state patrolman, who took Breithaupt to St. Charles Hospital in Bend. At the hospital, Breithaupt was given first aid treatment for carbon monoxide poisoning from fumes from his truck. Breithaupt was later released from the hospital and allowed to return home.

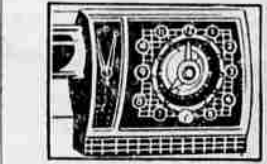

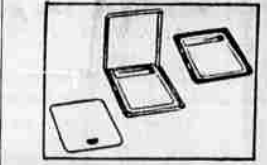

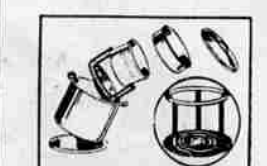
