Gunfire Erupts In Chinatown

BOSTON (AP)—Two men were killed and a third injured in a wild outbreak of gunfire in Boston's Chinatown last night.

Police said Pung Lee, 50, former owner of a Chinese restaurant, killed Jim Chin Kai, 59, an assistant secretary of the Chinese Merchants Assn., and wounded Wong Jayne, 59, Chinatown mayor. Lee himself was killed by police bullets.

The shootings took place on a balcony of the Chinese Mercantile Building and in one of the conference rooms, as hundreds of persons looked on from the street.

Police said the shootings began when Lee burst into a conference room filled with merchants and tried to win intervention in a Canadian deportation case in which he said he was involved.

Police said Lee went wild when informed by Jayne and Chin Kai that they could do nothing to help. He pulled out a gun. A dozen merchants fled to the street and a call was put in for the police.

Chin Kai was chased to the balcony and killed. Lee then fired through a window and created the mayor's chest with a bullet.

Lee, shooting wildly, fled into the conference room and locked the door. Deputies fired through the door and killed him with two shots.
