Senator Humphrey Urges Civil Rights Legislation

WASHINGTON (AP) — Sen. Humphrey (D-Minn) called on the Eisenhower administration today to "exercise its leadership rather than its lungs" in obtaining congressional action on civil rights legislation.

Chipman Tells Of New Plant

Chipman Chemical Company, Inc. will build a 2,4-D plant at Portland, Oregon. The plant will adjoin their office and factory, located at 6200 Northwest St. Helens Road. Construction will begin immediately.

This announcement was made by J. D. "Doc" Verrees, Klamath Falls agent. He advised that the new plant is to be the first of its kind in the Pacific Northwest. It will produce a complete line of 2,4-D and 2,4,5-T weed killers for consumer use, as well as 2,4-D and technical ester forms of 2,4-D and 2,4,5-T, including the low volatile esters.

Verrees stated that Chipman Chemical Company believes that its new plant will answer a long felt and growing need for complete 2,4-D manufacturing facilities in the Northwest. This need results from the increasing use of 2,4-D and other hormone weed killers, particularly in the grain growing areas of the Northwest. The added facilities, he said, will place his company in a position to serve the farmers and other 2,4-D users to the best possible advantage.

Chipman Chemical Company has been supplying agricultural pesticides in the Northwest for over a quarter of a century. It has several other plants and offices; executive offices are at Bound Brook, New Jersey.

"I didn't know the Supreme Court was Republican or Democratic," Humphrey said. "Vice President Nixon might do well to study the Constitution, as President Eisenhower evidently has done."

This was an apparent reference to a Jan. 25 statement by Eisenhower that "confusion between politics and the Supreme Court" should be avoided.

Stennis told the Senate yesterday that Nixon's statement had acknowledged "officially" that the court's desegregation decision was—in Stennis' words—"purely a political one."

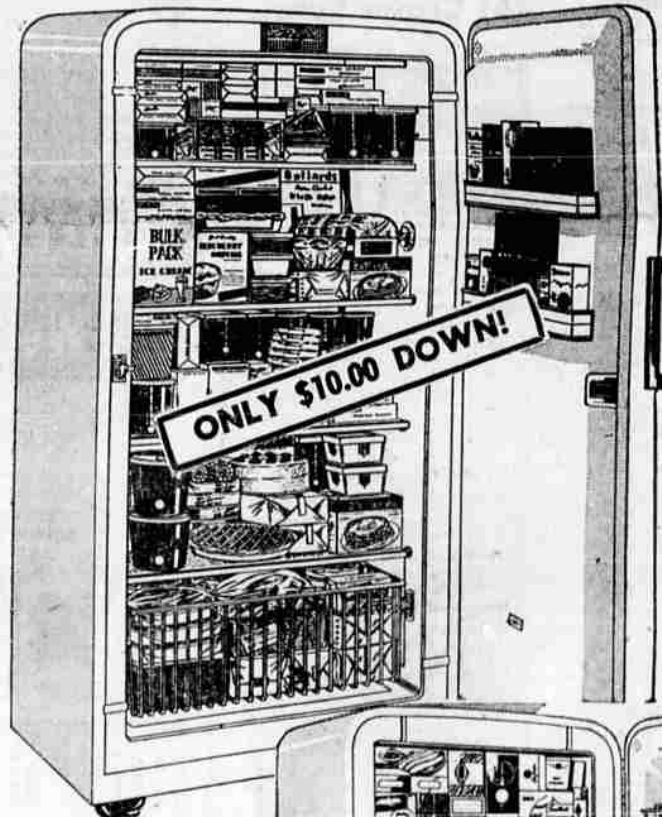

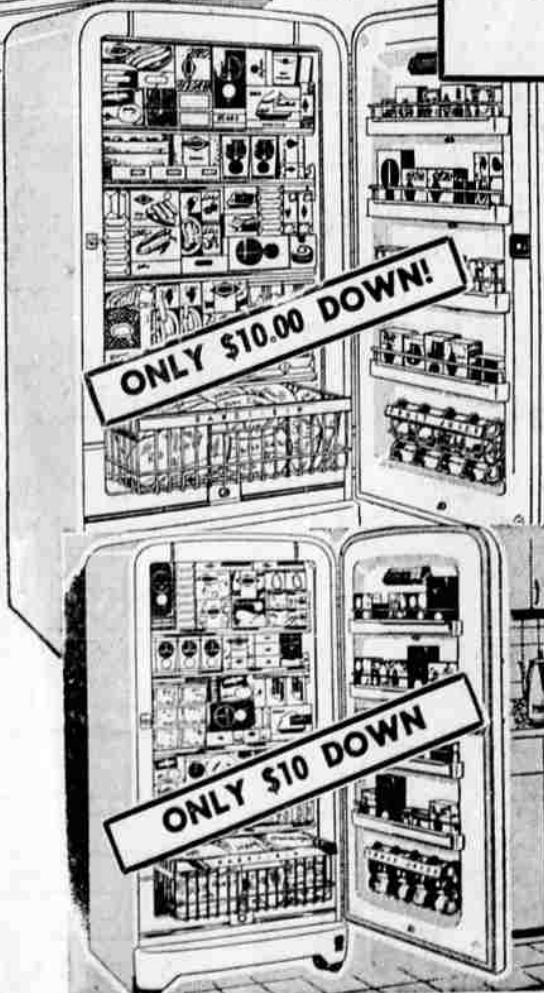

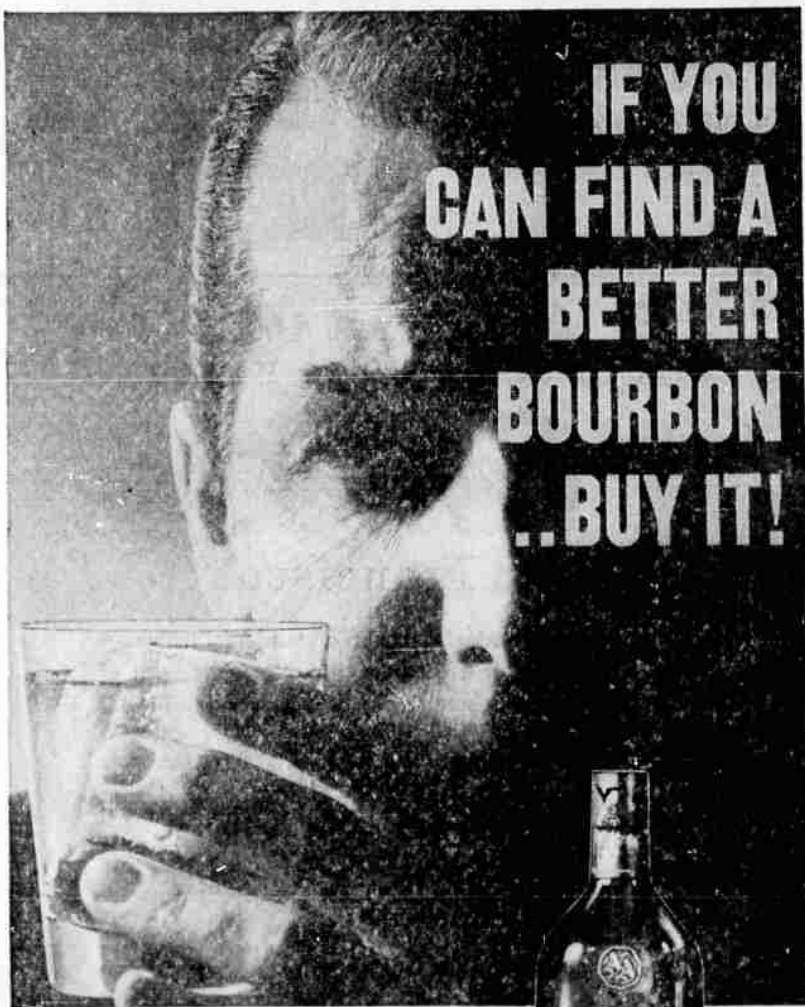
