Shirt Tale

There's precious little a man can call his very own these days. Not even the shirt on his back.

When he can't wear them any more—as shirts—you can, girls and not necessarily as a masquerade costume, either.

Tide Washing Clinic suggests this shorty nightgown from one of Pop's old shirts.

With 4½ yards of eyelet ruffling which can be purchased in most variety stores at no great cost, make yourself a shorty nightgown. A blue shirt was used for the nightgown in the photograph.

Remove collar and cuffs. To give puff-sleeve effect, put a hem in each sleeve and insert narrow elastic. Finish off each sleeve with an edging of 2-inch ruffling.

Use inch wide ruffling to edge each side of the button tab. Set two rows of inch wide ruffling to neck band. Add a border of two-inch ruffling around bottom of shirt to give added length.

The bottom part below the last shirt button is sewed up because the upper buttons allow plenty of opening to get in and out of the shorty nightgown.

SPRING CLEANING TIP

1 teaspoon grated onion
1 (1½ or 7-ounce) can tuna
Cut olives into large pieces. Beat eggs well and combine with milk, crumbs, salt, pepper and onion. Drain off oil and flake tuna. Stir

tuna and olives into first mixture. Turn into greased 1-quart baking dish and set in pan of hot water. Bake in moderate oven (350 degrees) 40 to 45 minutes, or until set in center. Serve at once. Makes 3 to 4 servings.

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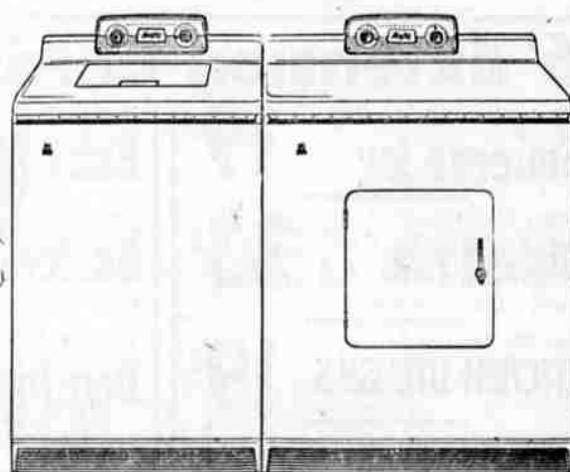
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
