Sale of timber, Klamath Indian Reservation, sealed bids to be received at the Klamath Indian Agency, Klamath Falls, Oregon, until 2:00 p.m., February 21, 1956, for the purchase of timber on a tract of 15 acres of timber land described as S. 1/4, N. 1/4, E. 1/4, Section 22, T. 22 N., R. 12 E., S. 1/4, E. 1/4, Oregon. The tract contains an estimated stand of 100,000 board feet of ponderosa pine, and an undetermined volume of lodgepole pine which will not enter into the determination of value. Each bidder must state the price per thousand feet B. M. Scribner Decimal Log Scale that will be paid for timber to be cut and skid. No bid will be considered for less than \$24.00 per thousand feet B. M. for ponderosa pine and \$3.00 per thousand feet B. M. for lodgepole pine. A certified check in the amount of 20 per cent of the total bid price on a solvent bank, payable to the Bureau of Indian Affairs, must accompany each bid. The deposits will be returned to the successful bidder within 30 days of acceptance of the bid. The right to waive technical defects and to reject any and all bids is reserved. The contract will specify that all designated timber be cut and removed from the unit on or before December 31, 1956, and that all other requirements of the contract including slash disposal will be completed by the end of the year. An additional payment in the amount of 10 per cent of the estimated value of the bid price will be required at the time of final payment and in any case not later than thirty days from the date of approval of the contract. The contract will be required to be made on the 10th day of March, 1956, and the last publication thereof to be made on the 9th day of March, 1956.
