Arctic Natives Aided By Planes

ELMENDORF AIR FORCE BASE, Alaska (AP) - An Air Force C-124 cargo plane Friday dropped twelve tons of emergency supplies to the hard-pressed natives on Little Diomed Island, which sits astride the Bering Strait only 30 miles from Soviet Siberia.
The supplies were parachuted to the direction of Alaska Gov. B. Frank Heinemann, who said the natives were running dangerously short of food, fuel and other necessities.
Supply ships were unable to reach the island last October.
Little Diomed is only two miles from Russian-owned Big Diomed Island and the frigid waters of the strait separate the two islands.
