Soviets Mark Red Army Day

LONDON (AP) — Soviet military leaders marked Red Army Day with calls today for vigilance against "intrigues of aggressive forces" and assertions that Russia has "reliable means" for delivering a "tomato and hydrogen bomb" to any part of the world.
Moscow radio broadcast an article in the Communist party newspaper Pravda by Marshal Vasily D. Sokolovsky concerning Russia's nuclear power.
Sokolovsky, chief of staff of the Soviet armed forces, declared the Soviet Union "has at its disposal reliable means for sending atomic and hydrogen bombs to any part of the world." He did not say whether he meant airplanes or intercontinental missiles, but he added that the Soviet army now is equipped with "long-distance rockets and guided missiles."
"We speak of this," he said, "not because we want to intimidate anyone but because it is sometimes worthwhile to remind those who time and again brandish atomic bombs that in our days one cannot wage war without being subject to retaliation."
Defense Minister Marshal Georgi K. Zhukov, in an order of the day, urged the Soviet Union's armed forces to strengthen the nation's defense capacities.
He charged that "aggressive circles of imperialist states continue to pursue a policy of force, of extending aggressive military blocs and accelerating armaments."
