

### Library Club Event Set To Aid Children's Benefit

Seventy tonsillectomies for worthy Klamath children have been financed by the Klamath Falls Woman's Library Club since the inauguration of its children's case benefit fund seven years ago. The seventh annual bridge tea sponsored by this group Saturday at 1 p.m. in the Willard Hotel will benefit this fund.

Mrs. A. Ivan Thompson, fund chairman, and Mrs. Oliver Spiker,

club treasurer announced completion of the 70th operation for removal of tonsils and adenoids this week. Some of the cases were simple, needing only the operation in a doctor's office, allowing the child to return to his home that evening, the women reported. These were relatively inexpensive.

Other cases were more complicated, they said. The child needing pre-operative care to build up

resistance, for example, with actual surgery in the hospital and necessary care there afterward. Such cases were much more expensive for the club.

All funds derived from the event Saturday and donations at the silver tea, benefit this charitable work of the library club. Eligible children are selected with help of teachers and school nurses of the local health department by a committee of club members and local physicians. Actual medical work is done for a nominal or token fee through cooperations of Klamath doctors.

Mrs. James Thornton, chairman

of the decorations committee, has announced a program to follow the card play, for which women are asked as in the past to bring their own cards and card table covers.

Suzanne Kulac of Malin will present two dances, the Mexican Hat dance and a Toreador dance. Mrs. Don Miller, soprano, will sing a group of three Latin-American folk songs, accompanied at the piano by Mrs. George McIntyre. "Flowing River," a Mexican birthday song and "Cielito Lindo" will be Mrs. Miller's selections.

Arthur Humphrey of Fremont Junior High School, tenor, will

sing a group of songs including "South of the Border" as another feature of the program, which will precede the tea. He will be accompanied by Ruth Lobaugh at the piano.

Presiding during the tea hour, for which Mrs. Chester J. Stonecypher of Tulelake and her committee are making plans, will be Mrs. Ray W. Oldenburg, first chairman of the Children's Case Benefit fund for the club, and Mrs. M. E. Ferebee, president of the club for 1955-56.

With Mrs. Walter Brown, then club president, Mrs. Oldenburg helped set up plans for the fund when the club initiated the tonsil-

lectomy program.

Only children ineligible for welfare fund or any other type of help, whose parents or guardians are truly unable to afford necessary operations, are eligible for help from the library club.
