Tax Code Allows Limited Allowances For Child Care

(Editor's Note: Allowable child care deductions are of great concern to many individuals filing their federal income tax returns. The Oregon Association of Public Accountants' tax information committee has prepared the following discussion, presented by the Herald and News as a reader service.)

The federal income tax code allows a deduction for child care to women and widowers. However the allowance is extremely limited.

This deduction is designed to give some relief to those who must pay others to care for their dependents in order to make a living themselves.

A "widower" is defined as a divorced man or one who is separated from his wife under a decree of separate maintenance at the close of the taxable year, as well as a man whose spouse has died and who has not remarried.

Norblad Backs Highway Plans

Congressman Walter Norblad, Republican of Oregon, who has entered the race for governor, assured Klamath County Judge U. E. Reeder Thursday that he is in complete accord with highway expansion legislation.

In a letter from Washington to Judge Reeder, Norblad stated:

"I assure you I am a strong advocate of the highway program and will give it my every support. At the last session of Congress, we had a conflict between the two major political parties here over their respective proposals.

"As one who wanted a road program," Norblad continued, "without regard for party politics involved, I voted for both proposals. I first supported the 'pay as you go' proposal and then when that failed, I voted for the 'bond issue' proposal.

"Very unfortunately," he concluded, "because of the political conflict, the legislation was never enacted. I hope sincerely that all members of Congress, no matter what their political leanings, will close ranks and have a good sound highway program enacted and on the books at the earliest possible moment."

Congressman Norblad made his statement in answer to an inquiry from Judge Reeder in which the lawmaker's support for the highway program was asked.

how many children or dependents the taxpayer has and how much more than \$600 may have been paid for their care. If less than \$600 was paid, then only the amount actually spent is deductible.

The child must be the taxpayer's daughter, stepdaughter, son or stepson and must be under 12 years of age. If any dependent, regardless of age, is physically or mentally incapable of self-care, expenses paid for his or her care for the purpose of enabling the taxpayer to be gainfully employed are deductible.

Those entitled to this deduction are a widow, widower, a married woman who files a joint return with her husband, or an unmarried person who is divorced, or legally separated from her or his husband or wife.

In the case of a married working mother filing a joint return with her husband, the combined adjusted gross income will determine the amount of deduction that may be claimed. If the combined income is \$4,500 or less, the maximum deduction of \$600 will be allowed. The excess of \$4500 will reduce the allowable deduction by any such excess.

If the taxpayer is employed only part time and the amount paid for child care covers a longer period of time, then only that portion paid when the taxpayer is gainfully employed will be allowed as a deduction. For example, a working mother pays a nursery \$20 per week in care for her child from 8 a.m. until 12 noon, then one-half the child care costs or \$10 per week would be allowed as a deduction.

Some of the important things to remember concerning this deduction are: The care of the child or dependent must be for the purpose of enabling the taxpayer to be gainfully employed, the expenses must be paid in the year in which they are incurred, the child must be under 12 years of age, and the maximum deduction is \$600 regardless of how many children the taxpayer may have.
