City Council Hears Final Reading Of Bond Ordinance

The Klamath Falls city council Monday night heard the third and final reading of an ordinance placing an \$800,000 sewerage system improvement bond issue on the May 18 primary.

The bond issue would be used for urgently needed improvements and additions to the city's sewerage line system and for the building of a new sewerage treatment plant.

City Engineer E. A. Thomas read a letter from Deputy State Sanitary Engineer Kenneth Spies expressing approval of the Klamath Falls sewerage system improvement plan. Spies agreed that changes in the city's system have been needed for many years.

FINAL READING

The council also heard the third and final reading of a corrected ordinance placing a one year two mill tax levy on the May 18 primary for the purchase of Gens Stadium from the stockholders of Klamath Baseball Incorporated. This levy would raise about \$28,000 for the purchase of the stadium which is reported to be valued at from \$75,000 to \$50,000.

Increasing damage to Klamath Falls buildings by termites was reported to the council by City Building Inspector Vern Schwartz. Schwartz displayed a wooden joint taken from a recently remodeled downtown building. The big joint

was almost completely eaten away by the termites.

The building inspector was instructed by the council to study the termite control ordinances of other cities and report back to the council.

DUMP TRUCK BIDS

Bids for a four-wheel drive dump truck to be used by the city's street department were opened and read by Police Judge Frank Blackmer. The three bids on the truck were: Jim Olson Motors, \$9,493.03 net; Juckeland Truck Sales, \$7,943 net, and Remington-Jackman Co., Portland, \$9,769 net. The bids were referred to City Engineer E. A. Thomas for study.

Lucas Furniture Co. bid \$665.35 for mattresses needed by the city fire and Carlson Mattress Co. offered a bid of \$667 for the mattresses.

The Klamath Council of Camp Fire Girls asked the council for permission to stage their annual essay sale in Klamath Falls from April 14 to 18. The council approved the sale. Proceeds from the sale will be mostly used for the maintenance of Camp Esther Applegate at Lake of the Woods, the latter from the Camp Fire leaders stated.

FIREMEN TO MEET

Fire Chief Roy Rowe said that he will meet Wednesday with representatives of the Suburban Fire Department and the U.S. Air Force

fire department at the Klamath Falls Municipal Airport. The firemen will work out their plans for mutual assistance in firefighting.

On request from City Engineer Thomas the council will ask for bids soon on 60 street name signs to be erected in the city by the street department.

Navy Reveals 'Freeze' Death

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Navy Tuesday reported the second death in Operation Deep Freeze in the antarctic. Seabee Driver 2-C Max H. Kiel was killed when his tractor crashed into a deep snow crevasse.

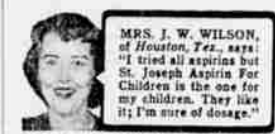
Kiel was the son of Mrs. Roma Irene Kiel, Box 32, Joseph, Ore. A dispatch to the Navy, from Little America said Kiel was driving in a tractor train carrying fuel oil drums from the coast to an inland base under construction for scientific studies in connection with the International Geophysical Year.

The tractor train departed from Little America on Feb. 27 and ran into a heavy snow storm which halted progress several times.

The party encountered several crevasses, the worst one about 14 feet wide and 110 feet deep. Kiel and other tractor men were filling the larger crevasse with snow when his vehicle plunged through surface snow into an undetected crevasse. The tractor and its driver dropped so far and fast through the ice and snow that the body could not be recovered.

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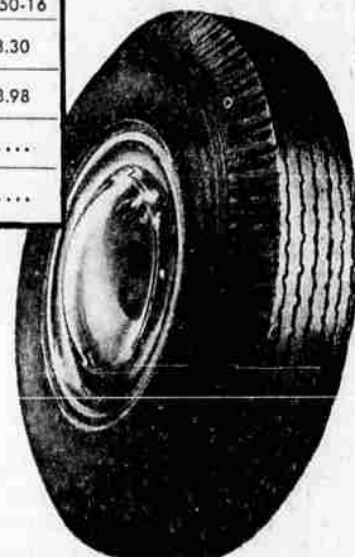

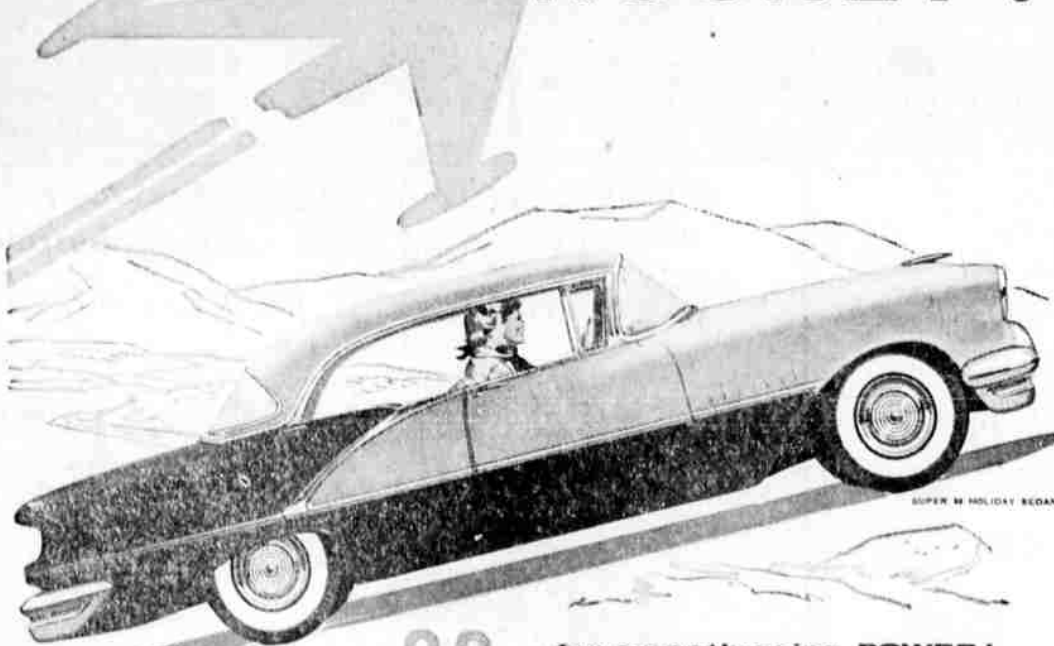
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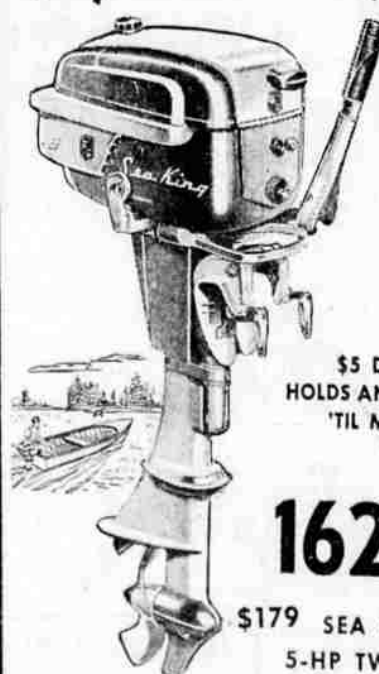
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
