Estes Claims Advancement
WASHINGTON (UP)—Sen. Estes Kefauver said today he thinks he is gaining ground in both New Hampshire and Minnesota, where he faces his first two presidential primary contests against Adlai E. Stevenson.
Back in Washington for voting on the farm bill, Kefauver told a reporter he expects to get "a majority of a little better than a majority" of the national convention delegates elected in New Hampshire next Tuesday.
He would make no forecast about Minnesota, where he is backing the state organization headed by Sen. Hubert H. Humphrey and Gov. Orville L. Freeman. They are backing Stevenson.
"I think I'm gaining ground in Minnesota," Kefauver said. "If I could just spend more time there." New Hampshire will have eight delegate votes at the Democratic National Convention. It will not provide a head-on clash between Stevenson and Kefauver because Stevenson did not formally enter the primary. However, a slate of pro-Stevenson delegate candidates entered against a slate pledged to Kefauver.
Minnesota, which holds its primary a week after New Hampshire, will have 10 delegate votes at the national convention. Both Kefauver and Stevenson consented to the entry of full delegate slates, but the Tennessee senator staked out a claim to an underdog role from the outset.
