Precipitation this season in the Pit River Basin as of February 1 was equal to 190 per cent of normal. Modoc National Forest Supervisor Neal M. Rahm reported recently.

He added that on the same dates, figures for Surprise Valley Basin were 180 per cent in 1956 and 70 per cent in 1955.

In this connection, the second in a series of four annual snow measurements have been completed at different forest locations. District Ranger Ken Smith and assistant Dick Miller of Adin measured the Sweagert Flat snow course March 1 and found the average snow depth to be 48.4 inches with a 15.6 inch water content. Maximum snow depth was 66 inches.

Similar measurements were also

made in the Cedar Pass area March 1 by forest officers Harold Hunter Jr. and Luther Price. On this course average snow depth

was found to be 69.7 inches with an average water content of 24.7 inches. Maximum depth measured was 82 inches.

Snow depths and water content are well above the ten year averages for March 1 and just under the record year 1952.

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
