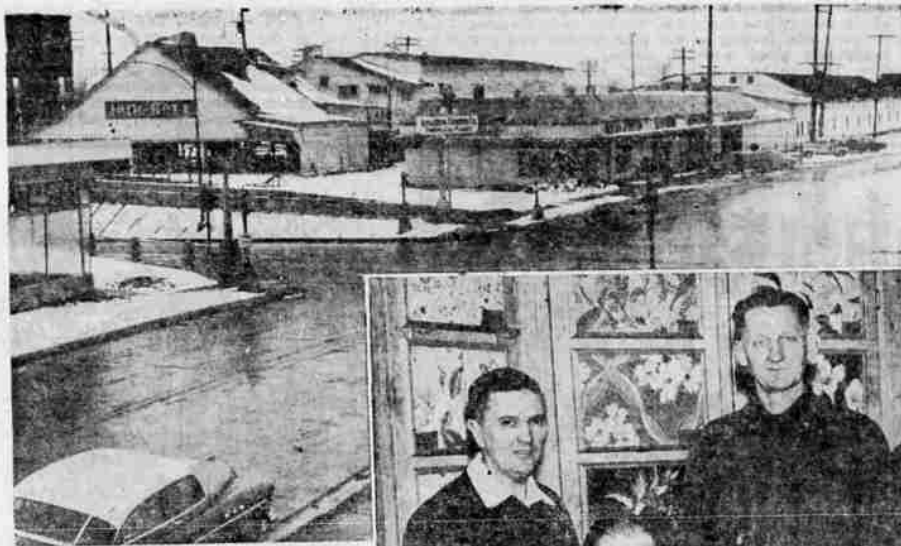


IN OREGON SINCE 1908
