Since its founding March 1, 1948, Car-Ad-Co Company has become one of the leading pine lumber remanufacturing operations on the west coast. The new, modern planing mill installed in 1950 has a capacity of surfacing 100,000 board feet of rough lumber every 8-hour shift. Sixteen dry-kilns have a

capacity of properly drying 3-million board feet of lumber per month.

Car-Ad-Co adds many dollars to the economy of Klamath County by remanufacturing rough lumber produced in Klamath, Lake, Jackson, Josephine and Douglas counties in Oregon and Siskiyou, Modoc, Shasta and Lassen counties in California.

Car-Ad-Co Company is a permanent, stable industry for the Klamath Basin. Plant operations keep in line with the wood-conservation policies so vitally important in the Pacific Northwest today. Pine lumber off-fall, left from the manufacture of major items, goes into sash and door cut stock, box shook, toy stock for building blocks,

heel stock for women's wooden heels, curtain-shade rollers and core stock for veneer doors. More than 50 car loads of these pine materials are shipped from the Car-Ad-Co plant each year. Total annual car-lot shipments of finished products is approximately 1,200.

By Recreating a sound and substantial forest industry out of the abandoned Pelican Bay Lumber Co. plant, Car-Ad-Co has added \$1 $\frac{1}{4}$ million annually to the economy of the Klamath Basin!
