British Resentment Rises Against U.S. Diplomat

LONDON (AP)—A storm of resentment against the United States gathered in Britain today as the House of Commons assembled for debate on the boiling Cyprus issue.

Almost all British newspapers wrote furiously of U.S. Ambassador Cavendish Cannon's statement to the Greek government expressing "the sympathetic concern of the U.S. government over recent developments in Cyprus."

PANAMA (AP)—Juan D. Peron, ousted president of Argentina, has challenged his successor, provisional President Pedro Aramburu, to a duel. Reporters were shown a copy of a registered letter addressed to Aramburu suggesting the duel be held on the Argentine frontier. Peron said he had read news dispatches in which Aramburu described him as a "coward" and suggested meeting on a field of honor "if you have doubts as to my personal valor."
