Inexpensive insulation board is a material made by exploding wood or cane fibers into sheets. The sheets are given an unblemished surface, attractive and eye-appealing, with a high light-reflecting value. No further finish is required.

Insulation board, as its name implies, has a high heat resistance and also hushes noise. You can get it in panels, planks or tile sizes. It is especially useful for covering dirty concrete walls in basements where it is installed on furring strips. Tile sizes make attractive ceilings.

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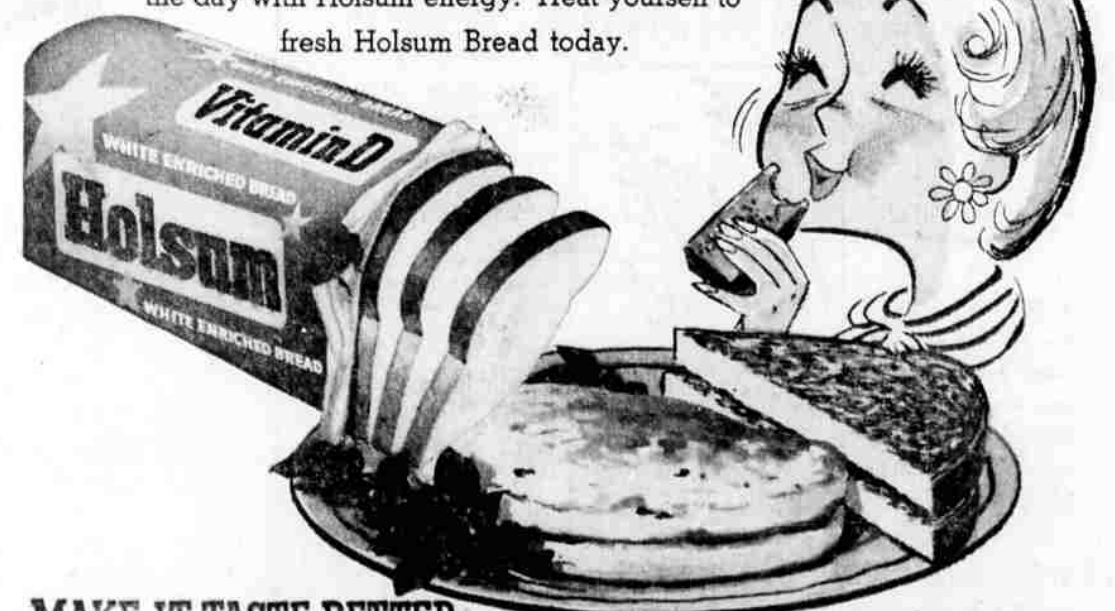
