Honduras Girl Studies At SOC

A pretty girl from Tegucigalpa, Honduras, daughter of a former president of the supreme court in her homeland, is learning the English language to be prepared to greet Americans who come to the

bank where she is employed in Honduras.

Estela Pavon, guest during the spring vacation of Sheila Adler and her parents, Dr. and Mrs. George H. Adler, is a student at Southern Oregon College, Ashland, where Sheila also attends.

She has been in this country since January of this year, yet has learned English well enough to converse with little hesitation. She began her studies in Louisiana State Institute where she stayed for eight weeks but found the strong Creole accent there did not favor her learning a purer form of the language.

Estela began her career in the business world at the age of 15 years when she went to work on a daily newspaper, El Dia (The Day) as a reporter. She has also edited a book of poetry. She will be 23 years old July 23 and plans to return to her work in Honduras in two years when she expects to be able to speak English fluently. Police Impose Gathering Ban

MANAMA, Bahrain (AP) — Police imposed a ban on afternoon gatherings of more than five persons Friday as a general strike marked by violence entered its fifth day.

An Iraqi police unit of 140 men is en route from Baghdad to reinforce police at Bahrain.

Strikers have blocked roads at several points, punctured tires and stoned automobiles. Some cars have been set afire.

The strike which first was localized quickly blossomed into action throughout the Bahrain islands. It appears partly inspired by a movement for more governmental power for the people, and partly aimed at the ruler's British adviser, Sir Charles Bragg.

The spokesman said Egyptian positions opened up with machine-gun and rifle fire four times at Israeli outposts in the Kiasufim and Beeri areas.

He said the Israelis returned fire. There were no casualties.

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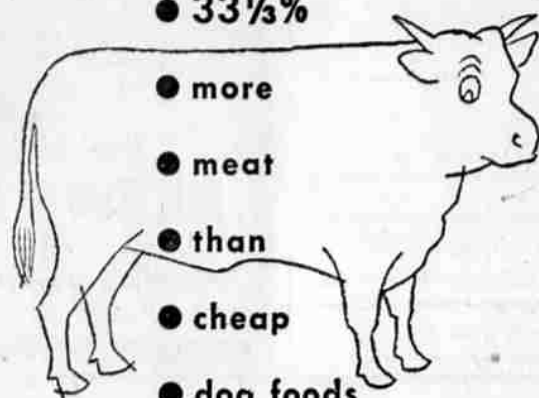
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
