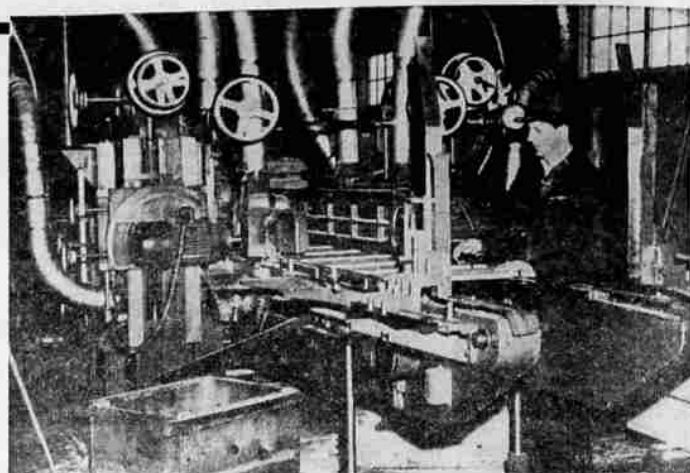


MODERN BUILDING CALLS FOR PRECISION MILLWORK!

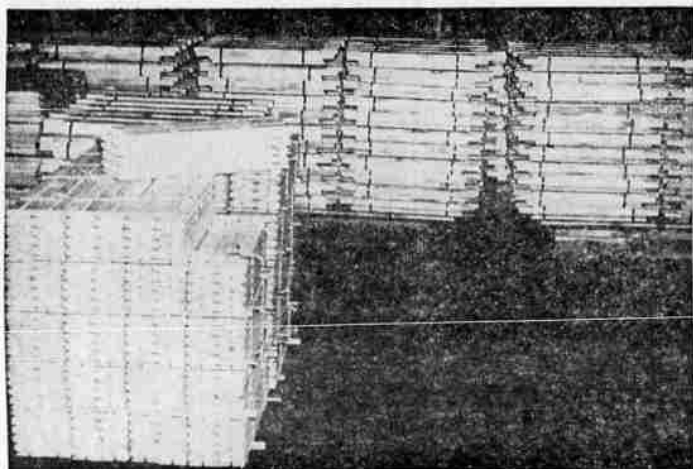
**... and Metler Bros.

Metler Bros. has grown from a small plant, employing 15 men to one of this sections leading manufacturing plants with 60 employees. Between six and seven million board feet of locally-produced lumber are processed each year. The windows, and door frames produced by Metler Bros. are ready for the carpenter to assemble them. The frames are cut, grooved, and given termite and water repellent treatment before they leave the shop.
