

Wood Industries Division To Hold Meeting In Portland

Subjects of interest to sawmill and construction men, and other users of wood, will be discussed in the wood industries division of the American Society of Mechanical Engineers at the Multnomah Hotel in Portland, March 19-23.

Milton H. Mater of Mater Machine Works, Corvallis, Archie C. Knauss of the Pacific Northwest Forest and Range Experiment Station, Portland, and Thomas R. Miles, consulting engineer, will speak about band head rigs, dry kilns and log barking.

Julius W. Mann, of Mann-Russell Electronics, Vern Ketchum of Timber Structures, Inc., and James W. Johnson of the Oregon Forest Products Laboratory will speak on radio-frequency gluing and drying, glued-laminated timber construction, and strength tests of large wood diaphragms.

Dale E. Schubert, Industrial Development Company, Tacoma, will report on particle board manufacture. Stanley E. Corder, Oregon Forest Products Laboratory, Corvallis, will describe study on

wood particle drying. Herman H. Amberg, Engineering Experiment Station, Oregon State College, will discuss production of cattle feed from waste sulfite liquor.

Elmer E. Matson, Pacific Northwest Forest and Range Experiment Station, will tell of sandwich construction with wood-base materials. Rex Reynolds, Kennametal, Inc., Latrobe, Pennsylvania, will talk about use of tungsten carbide in wood milling.

The speakers have had years of experience that will make their talks of value to members of wood industries, according to George H. Atherton, reporting representative of the Wood Industries Division, ASME.

In addition to the technical reports, the dean of the School of Forestry, Oregon State College, W. F. "Mac" McCulloch, will relate the history of Northwest logging, a real treat in itself.

Other subjects of interest to workers with wood will be given at the meeting in other divisions of the society.

Field trips will round out the four-day program for the several hundred men expected to attend the technical sessions.

Yreka Council Bucks Sales Tax

YREKA — The city council Thursday night went on record unanimously against a county wide sales tax. The sales tax issue is to be discussed at the Siskiyou County Board of Supervisors meeting in Yreka March 20.

The tax should only encourage more California business to go to Oregon, since Yreka is so near the state line, Yreka councilmen felt.

Local Sears Employees Get Report On Profit Sharing

Sharing in their company's successful year, 42 employee-members of the Sears, Roebuck and Company profit sharing fund in the local store learned last week that their investment in the fund now amounts to \$252,778.

This figure was announced today by Robert Egge, local Sears manager, at a meeting of fund members. At this meeting the employees received their 1955 statements showing the extent to which they shared in the company's profits last year and the value of their individual accounts.

The local members have 5,300 shares of Sears stock and a cash balance of \$81,978 to their credit in the fund, Egge explained. Taking the year-end market value of \$36 per share for the Sears stock and adding the cash and miscellaneous investments brings the group's total investment to \$252,778.

Membership in the Savings and Profit Sharing Fund of Sears, Roebuck and Co. employees is open to

all regular employees with one year of service and today numbers more than 125,000 members throughout the nation.

Today the total assets of the fund exceed \$50 million dollars, of which slightly more than 100 million dollars represents deposits from the wages and salaries of its members.

The fund is also the largest single stockholder of the company, owning more than 25 per cent of the company's outstanding stock.

The fund was created by the company in 1916. Its purpose is to encourage regular saving, permit employees to share in the profits of their company and to aid members in establishing a financial reserve for their eventual retirement.

Under the provisions of the fund, employee-members deposit five per cent of their wages and salaries up to a \$500 maximum deposit each year. Sears makes an annual contribution to the fund based upon an established percentage of the company's net profit before deductions for federal income taxes.

The company's contribution is credited to the accounts of members on a basis of their length of service with Sears and their annual contribution.
