County FFA, 4-H Members To Enter SF Exposition

Six Klamath County 4-H and Future Farmers of America members will be among the several hundred exhibitors at the 10th annual Grand National Junior Livestock Exposition, which will be held from March 24-28 at the Cow Palace in San Francisco.

Five of six yearlings are shipping pens of five black Angus steers, while the sixth consists of shipping a single black Angus steer. Two of the steers are owned by members of the FFA, while the others are 4-H members.

The entrants in the FFA are Farrell Wilson, 16, and Doug Fisk, 15, both of Malin. Both are raising pens. The others are Harry Wilson, 14, Roxanne Wilson, 17, and Mary Jane Fisk, 13, all of Malin, and Elliott West, 16, of Poo Valley.

West is shipping the single steer. The Wilsons are the sons and daughters of Mr. and Mrs. Earl Wilson of Malin. In addition to 4-H work, Harry is active in school athletics, and was the manager of the state champion Malin Mustang basketball squad.

The Fisks are the children of Mr. and Mrs. Wayne Fisk, and West is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Gerald West.
