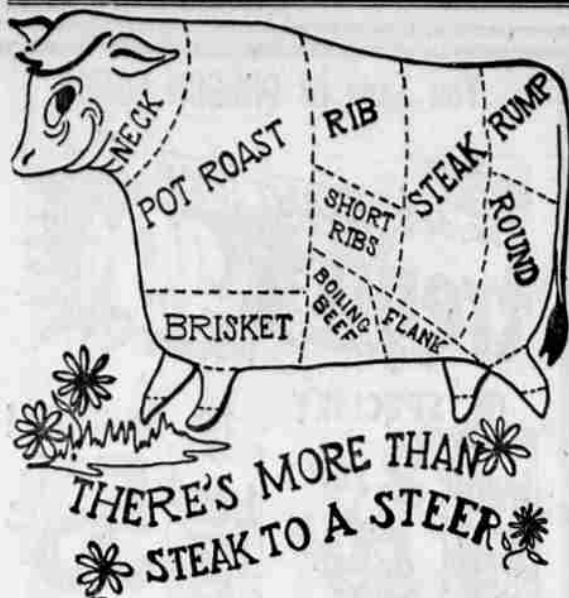




## Klamath Cow Belles

### USE BOTH HANDS

Have you ever noticed that usually one hand does all the work when you are doing household chores?

You save time and energy if you'll use two hands when polishing furniture, washing woodwork, scrubbing floors or any of the other household chores. And it isn't as difficult as it sounds. One hand may have to be trained to be in motion at the same time as the overworked one, but the results will make it worthwhile.

The same thought could carry over to cleaning equipment. When polishing furniture, apply the wax with one and use the other to polish the wood. If you can become completely ambidextrous, use two hands of water for the scrubbing. The right hand can apply the sudsy solution and the left follow right up with a cloth wrung out of clear water to wipe up the soil and leave the woodwork sparkling. Two hands also save steps to get extra water.

### Endive Entree

Endive is in season and here is a suggested way to prepare it. The recipe was prepared and tested by Milo Miloradovich, food expert, whose books have been published by Doubleday & Co., Inc., New York, and Word Locke & Co., Ltd., London.

#### ENDIVES VINAIGRETTE

##### X'OEufs

(Belgian Endive Buffet)

Platter with Eggs

- 4 large heads of Belgian endive
- 1 cup lukewarm water
- 2 teaspoons lemon juice
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 4 hardcooked eggs, sliced
- 2 hardcooked eggs, chopped
- 1/2 cup French dressing
- 2 teaspoons freshly-chopped parsley

1/2 pound cottage cheese, optional

Allow 1 large head Belgian endive or 2 small heads for each serving; more if desired.

Wash endive carefully; place in large shallow heavy pan; pour lemon juice over endive. Cover completely with lukewarm water; add salt. Place pan over medium flame; uncovered, cook vigorously 20 minutes or until tender but not overcooked. Remove from flame.

Drain endive carefully; arrange heads on serving platter. Pour French Dressing over endive. Allow to cool 15 minutes to room temperature. Garnish Belgian endive with chopped hard-cooked eggs; sprinkle with chopped parsley. Arrange hard-cooked egg slices on platter. Serve endive at room temperature with oven-heated French bread or thinly-sliced buttered rye bread.
