

NEW DESSERT CAKE

Here's a grand-new cake that's deliciously different! In texture it's half-way between sponge and butter cake. In taste so delectable that it defies description. And to front this new and different cake, we use a luscious Orange Blossom frosting. It's refreshing and colorful and literally melts in your mouth.

This is the last word in glamorous cakes and would make a happy ending to any meal or dinner party.

ORANGE BLOSSOM CAKE

1 1/4 cups C and H pure Cane Granulated Sugar
1/2 cup shortening (part butter for flavor)
2 eggs plus 2 yolks
1/2 cup orange juice
1/2 cup water
1/2 teaspoon lemon extract
2 cups sifted cake flour
1/2 teaspoon salt
2 teaspoons baking powder
1/4 teaspoon soda

Beat together sugar, shortening, and 1 egg with electric mixer at high speed about 3 minutes (or with spoon) until light and fluffy; scraping bowl often. Beat in other egg and yolks 1 at a time. Mix orange juice, water and lemon extract. Sift dry ingredients. Alternately add small amounts dry and liquid ingredients, beating just until smooth with mixer at low speed (or with spoon) after each

addition. Bake in 2 greased-and-floured 9" layer pans, at 375 (moderate) 20 to 25 minutes. Cool on racks, then frost with fluffy "Orange Blossom" frosting.

ORANGE BLOSSOM FROSTING
1 lb. (4 cups) C and H pure Cane Powdered Sugar
4 tablespoons butter
2 egg whites
Dash of salt
2 teaspoons grated orange peel or
1/2 teaspoon lemon extract
1 tablespoon orange juice or undiluted frozen orange concentrate

Sift sugar; gradually add about a third of it to the butter, creaming thoroughly with electric mixer, or with spoon. Beat in, one at a time, the unbeaten egg whites. Add dash of salt and grated orange peel (or lemon extract). Beat in rest of sugar and orange juice (or undiluted frozen orange concentrate). Tint delicate orange with yellow food coloring plus 1 or 2 drops red, and beat well. Spread in swirls on cool cake. Cover tops and sides of two 9 inch layers.

ORANGE BLOSSOM CAKE can be made with either fresh or frozen orange juice. If fresh orange juice is used, add two teaspoons grated peel. This cake, half-way between sponge and butter cake, is from the C and H Sugar Homemakers' Bureau. It is as springlike as the first daffodils of the season.

TOASTED DOUGHNUTS

Split leftover doughnuts, toast them under the broiler and, while still hot, spread them with butter and dip in sugar and cinnamon. Good for breakfast or any time.

MEAT LOAF

If you are short of time, you can reduce the time required for baking meat loaf by spooning the mixture into muffin pan cups and adding water to the pans that are not filled with meat in order to prevent burning. Serve with mashed potatoes and fried onions and dinner is ready in short order.



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
