**Tribal Council Slates Meeting**  
A special meeting of the Klamath Tribal Council will be held April 5 at the Klamath Council House, Klamath Agency, Dilbon Cook, tribal secretary, announced today.

Items on the agenda of the special meeting include a resolution on Indian forestry matters, proposed amendments to Public Law 587, the law which terminates federal control over the reservation, and health matters.

A luncheon will be served at about 11:30 a.m., Cook said.

The resolution on forestry, drawn at a recent meeting of the Tribal Executive Committee and the Board of Management Specialists, if adopted, would call for the sale of sufficient Indian timber to provide funds for continuing per capita payments until the final termination settlement.

**OTI Manager Promoted**  
W. M. (Jack) Douglass, business manager at Oregon Technical Institute since October, 1954, was recently promoted to a position as administrative assistant in the office of Director W. D. Purvine at the institute. Douglass has been assigned the responsibility of establishing an accounting controls system for all institute operations. A. E.
