

Young GOP's To Lay Off Hitchcock, McKay Bids For Primary Endorsement

Requests by two Republicans seeking nomination to the U.S. Senate that they not be endorsed by the state Young Republicans highlighted weekend political activity in Oregon.
The requests from Philip Hitchcock and Secretary of the Interior Douglas McKay were made public in Salem Saturday at an executive board meeting of the Young Republican Federation of Oregon.
A week ago the executive board of another Young Republican group, the Oregon College League of Young Republicans, approved a resolution endorsing Hitchcock and sent it to campus chapters for action.
Hitchcock, McKay and two lesser known candidates will vie

for the Republican nomination in the May 18 primary. The winner is expected to meet Democratic Sen. Wayne L. Morse in the November general election.
In other action, the Young Republican Federation directors Saturday refused to accept the resignation of Pat Roden of Salem, who quit as head of a program to sign up first-time voters. Roden resigned last Tuesday after accusing the party central committee of poor budget policies. Roden was given a vote of confidence Saturday.
Gov. Elmo Smith, seeking the Republican nomination for governor, appointed R. A. (Dick) Rawlinson, Salem businessman, to manage his campaign. Rawlinson operates a Salem laundry.

State Democratic leaders conducted a political school Saturday for 45 candidates for public office. Panels included campaign techniques, state party organization, and the organization of state government. Howard Morgan, state Democratic chairman, Monroe Sweetland, national committeeman, and Atty. Gen. Robert Y. Thornton were among the party officials who conducted the session.

The Young Democratic Clubs of Oregon invited Sen. Estes Kefauver (D-Tenn.) to attend its state convention in Portland April 21. But Vernon Cook of Gresham, president of the organization, said the invitation is not to be construed as group backing of Kefauver for the Democratic presidential nomination. The Tennessee senator has accepted the invitation.

The executive board of the Young Democratic Clubs Saturday reiterated the group's demand for stronger representation on the Democratic State Central Committee.

A proposed amendment allowing recall of central committee officers was approved by the executive committee of the Republican State Central Committee.

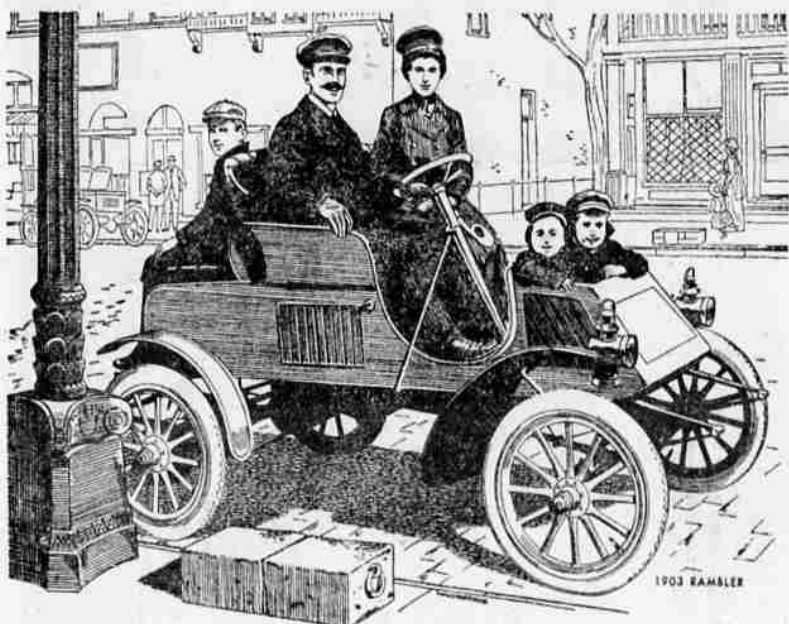
