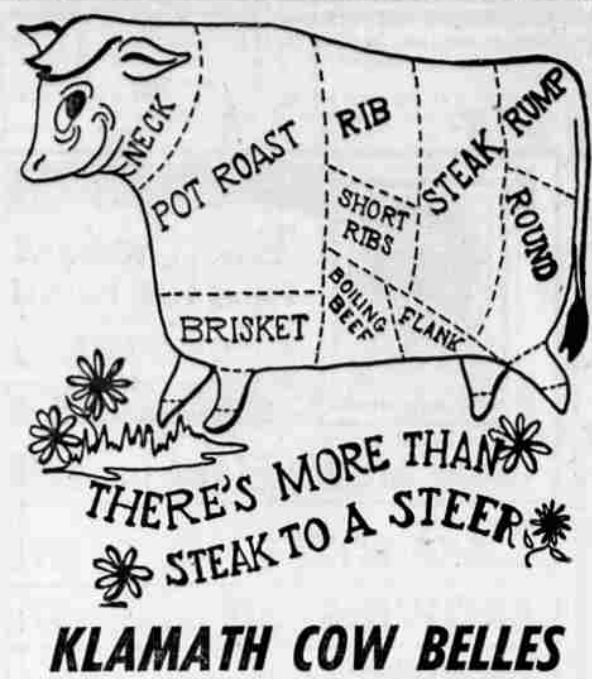

CRANBERRY MOLD

If you'd like to add a novel touch to dinner, consider this one: Open one No. 2 can of sliced peaches and drain the juice without removing the peaches. Soften one envelope of unflavored gelatin in 1/4 cup cranberry juice cocktail. Heat; add another 1/4 cup of the cranberry juice and stir until the gelatin is dissolved. Cool until slightly thickened, pour into the can of peaches and chill until firm. Remove the molded peaches from the can and cut through in layers; then cut layers in half to serve with your turkey dinner or as a garnish for a cold turkey platter.

dipped, oh I could go on and on about the costs of operation—for instance the fence crews, haying crews, irrigation, but think enough said on that. We have also had to winter these same cattle two winters on hay, which we have stacked or baled the previous summer, along with salt and meal for protein. At the end of the third summer we have two choices, either sell off the grass, at a lower price and shorter weight, or we can ship to the feed lot and produce a choice animal by finishing on grain, hay, molasses, meal and mineral. This concentrated feeding takes from three to six months. When shipping there are expenses of freight (either truck or train) and brand inspections. We also must abide by health and sanitary laws.

After reading this tale of woe you will probably wonder why we stay in the cow business but we were raised with it and no doubt will die with it. It's in our blood.

Garden Fresh Salad

It will be months before green onions and leaf lettuce can be grown here without danger of frost, but the markets are showing more and more fresh green vegetables. Tomatoes are improving in quality, fresh asparagus is good, and occasionally our grocers are able to get romaine and leaf lettuce here. The little onions and fresh radishes are fine now.

FRESH VEGETABLE RICE OLIVE SALAD

1-3 cup ripe olives
1 cup diced tomato
1 tablespoon diced green sweet pepper
1 tablespoon thinly sliced green onion
2 cups shredded lettuce
Tartar French dressing
Salted greens

Cut olives in large pieces. Combine olives, tomato, pepper, onion and lettuce. Toss lightly with French dressing. Serve on garnished salad plates.
Serves 6.

STUFFED CELERY

Instead of cheese, try stuffing celery with chopped chicken, ham or smoked turkey, using savory paste or mayonnaise well seasoned as a binder.

Surprise Salad

Combine onion and orange in a salad? Surprisingly enough they are a good team. Try this combination in a sparklingly pretty gelatin salad. That's why it's named "Nectar Surprise Salad."

NECTAR SURPRISE SALAD

1 1/2 cups apricot whole fruit-nectar
1/4 teaspoon salt
2 teaspoons sugar
1 envelope (1 tablespoon) plain gelatin
2 tablespoons cold water
2 tablespoons lemon juice
1 teaspoon mild prepared mustard
1/2 cup diced orange
2 teaspoons finely cut green onion
Salad greens
Mustard-mayonnaise dressing

Heat together nectar, salt and sugar. Soften gelatin in cold water and dissolve in hot nectar. Stir in lemon juice and mustard. Chill until slightly thickened. Blend in orange and onion. Chill until firm. Unmold and serve on crisp salad greens. Top with mustard-mayonnaise dressing. Makes 6 servings.

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
