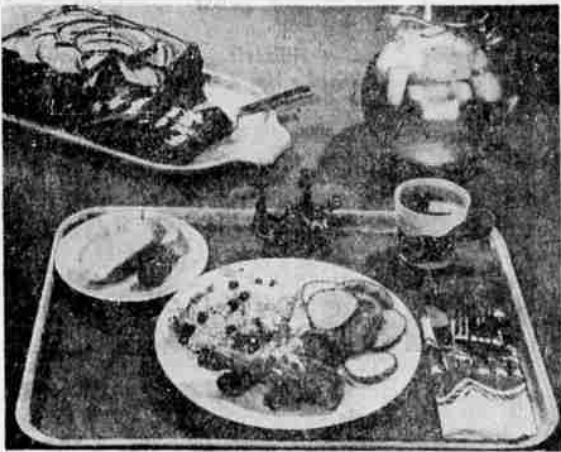

Easy Buffet Supper

For a different salad that doubles as a vegetable, use Minute Rice as the base and add a vegetable favorite like quick-frozen peas. This combination is flavordipped with a dressing made by combining oil and vinegar with an envelope of Good Seasons Salad Dressing Mix.

RICE AND VEGETABLE SALAD

- (Using salad dressing mix)
- 1-3 cups (5-ounce package) packaged pre-cooked rice
- 1/2 cup salad dressing mix (any flavor)
- 1 cup mayonnaise
- 1 tablespoon finely chopped onion
- 1/2 teaspoon curry powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon pepper
- 1/2 teaspoon dry mustard
- 1 cup diced celery
- 1 box (10 ounces) quick-frozen peas, cooked and drained

Prepare packaged pre-cooked rice as directed on the package. Combine dressing with warm rice, mixing lightly. Let cool to room temperature. Combine mayonnaise, onion, curry powder, salt, pepper, and dry mustard, mixing well. Add to celery and peas in large bowl; then add rice, mixing lightly with a fork. Chill at least 1 hour. Serve on crisp lettuce. Makes 8 1/2 cups or 6 servings luncheon or entree salad, or 10 to 12 servings side salad.

CHOCOLATE FROSTED MARBLE CAKE

- 1 package instant yellow cake mix
- 1 cup water
- 2 eggs, unbeaten
- 1 1/2 squares unsweetened chocolate, melted
- 1/2 teaspoon soda
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 3 tablespoons water
- Chocolate Butter Cream Frosting

Empty cake mix into bowl. Add 1 cup water and the eggs. Beat 3 minutes until smooth and creamy. Mix together chocolate, soda, and 1/2 cup of the water. Spoon batter into one 13x9x2-inch pan, which has been lined on
