Pan Affects Looks, Quality Of Cakes, OSC Research Shows

With the end of vacationtime, the family's demand for baked goods always goes up. Cakes, cookies and cupcakes will be finding their way into school lunch boxes and will be in great demand for after-school snacks, so Oregon State College's Home Economics Department has been doing some research on the pans in which cakes are cooked.

"When buying cake pans, remember that the kind of pan affects the quality and looks of the cake," states OSC home economist Helen Charley, who is associate professor of foods and nutrition. "Adjustment of oven temperature will not compensate for the difference in pan material," she added.

Dark or dull surface pans produce cakes of more velvety texture and higher over-all quality than shiny surface pans, Miss Charley has found in her research. Cakes also bake faster with greater volume or size from the same amount of batter.

The slower-baking, shiny-surfaced pans do produce cakes slightly better in appearance. Crusts are more evenly browned and tops more level and with less cracking.

In her latest study, Miss Charley tried adjusting oven temperatures to see if that would change the results produced in earlier pan material test comparisons.

She found similar quality and looks differences existed in cakes from the two types of pans even though the temperatures for the slow-baking pans were increased to the point that baking time was the same for both type pans.

In her earlier study, Miss Charley found that depth of pan is also a factor in determining cake quality. Cakes baked in shallower pans—under 2 inches—were better looking, better textured and more tender than those baked in deeper pans.

Red Pepper Marmalade

Wash 12 sweet red peppers and remove seeds. Save out 1 tablespoon of the seeds. Put peppers through food chopper. Add the seeds, 1½ teaspoons salt, 2 cups vinegar, 3 cups sugar and 1 tablespoon grated lemon peel. Cook to the consistency of jam or marmalade—about 30 minutes. Makes about 3 pints. Try it with cold meats or with crackers and cheese.
