Druggist Buys Mead Firm

W. R. (Bob) Waggoner has announced purchase of Mead's Drugs, 530 Main Street, from the estate of the late Pierre D. Mead.

The business is remaining open to serve the public during complete remodeling and redecorating of the store. All present merchandise is to be closed out "regardless of cost," Waggoner stated, before remodeling is completed and a complete new stock will be placed on the shelves.

The prescription department, enlarged and modernized, will be moved from the rear of the store to the front. The fountain will be moved to the back of the store with booths and other new features planned. The redesigned store will be a self-service type of operation to speed up assistance to the public.

Harold Hayden, in charge of the prescription department of Woods Drug Store for the last five years, will be the new manager.

Waggoner has also announced plans for an all-night drug dispensing service. This is a service not usually offered to cities under 100,000 population, he stated.

The service will follow the contemplated building and operation of a new drug store on land previously bought in the South Sub-

urban area. The long-range program will then involve four complete drug businesses to be operated by Waggoner. The Suburban Drug, Mead's, to be operated for the present under the same name, Waggoner's Drugs at 839 Main Street and the new store.
