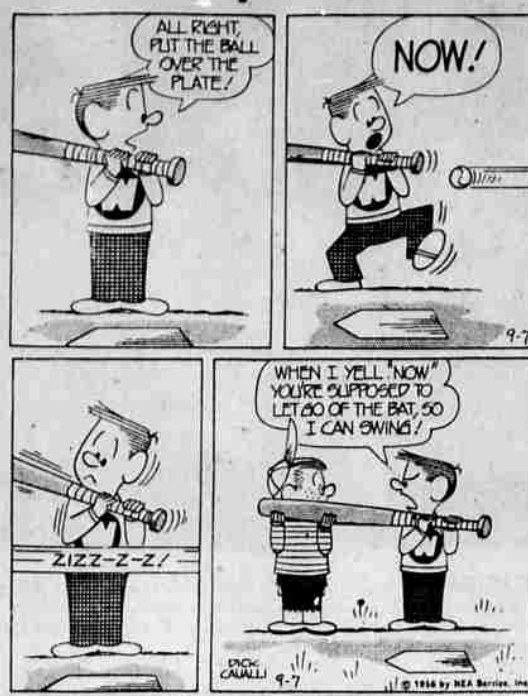

Timber Bids To Be Called

KLAMATH AGENCY — Approximately 5,600 acres of timber and grazing land are being offered for bid by the Klamath Indian Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs under bid invitation No. 11.

Bids will be opened on 43 tracts of land on October 2, at 2 p.m., at Klamath Agency, according to M. M. Zollar, assistant superintendent of the Klamath Indian Reservation.

The land advertised for sale is offered subject to existing leases of record with the Bureau of Indian Affairs. Non-Indian government employees will not be permitted to enter bids. Bids will be accepted from Indian employees of the government pursuant to the provisions of Section 276.5 (c) of C.F.R., Title 25-Indians.

Copies of the bid advertisement may be obtained from the office of the superintendent of the reservation and maps of the reservation are available for \$1 each.

Timber volume is not guaranteed on the land offered, but is estimated at approximately nine and three-quarters million board feet of ponderosa pine, two and one-half million feet of white fir and various stands of lodgepole pine, incense cedar and sugar pine.
