Scattered patches of rain drenched the nation's weather today.  
Light rain pelted the northern Rockies, the upper Mississippi Valley and northern Pacific Coast. Some showers also fell in the Great Lakes region.

Heaviest rainfalls occurred along the Gulf Coast and in southern Florida. West Palm Beach, Fla., collected nearly 1 1/2 inches of rain overnight after receiving a fall of about 1 1/4 inches yesterday.
