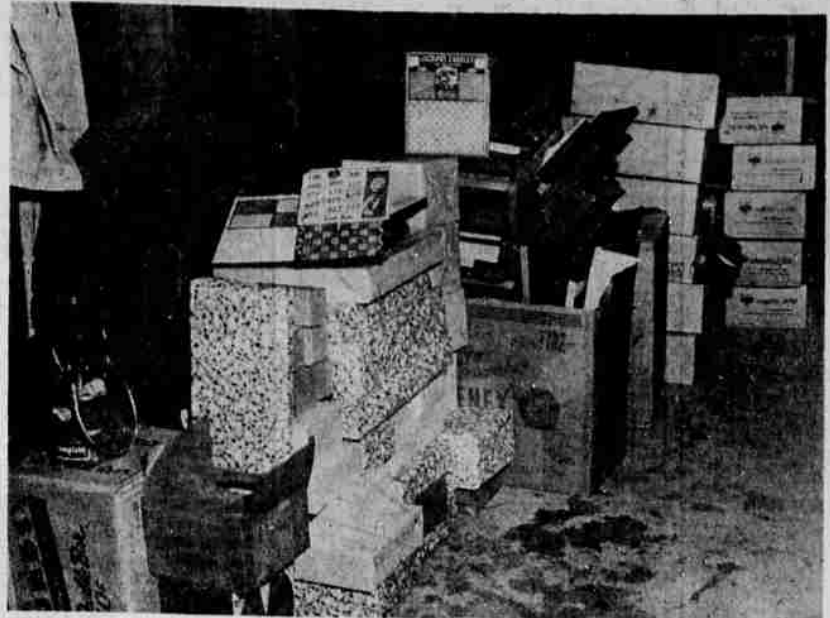




A GAMBLING CRACKDOWN by state and city police and the district attorney's office which was highlighted by a series of county-wide raids netted the gaming devices and merchandise pictured above. At the request of District Attorney Richard Beesley, state police made an undercover probe of gambling and then swooped down on taverns,

poolhalls and card rooms in all parts of the county. Fourteen policemen participated in the raids. Ten slot machines and 200 punch boards were seized as well as hundreds of dollars in merchandise which was to have been awarded to lucky punch board players. Beesley said that gambling laws will be rigidly enforced not only against commercial

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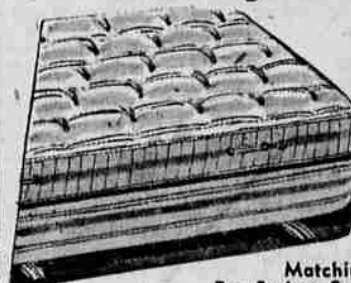

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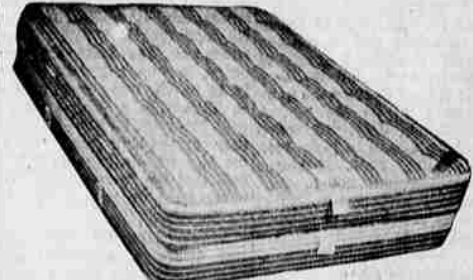

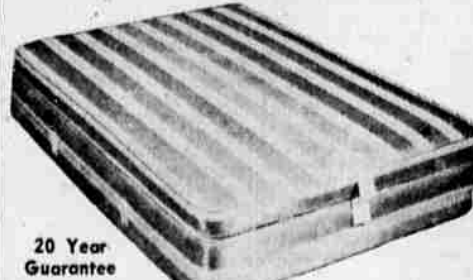
