

Ike Says Draft To Continue

WASHINGTON (UPI)—President Eisenhower, differing with Adlai E. Stevenson, sees no chance of ending the draft "in the immediate future."

Mr. Eisenhower told his news conference Tuesday that he would not use the words "foreseeable" in future in answering the question of whether the draft could be ended. But, he said that "in the immediate future," he sees no chance of ending the draft and carrying out the responsibilities of the security of this country.

Stevenson said last week that "we can now anticipate the possibility that within the foreseeable future we can maintain the military forces we need without the draft."

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
