### Nehru Hits Suez Group

NEW DELHI, India (AP)—Prime Minister Nehru today denounced Western plans to create a Suez Canal users' association.

He said he was "surprised" by British Prime Minister Eden's statement yesterday in the House of Commons and declared the "consequences would be very grave" because it closed the door to further negotiations with Egypt and implied an intention to impose a settlement.

Speaking in a Parliament session, Nehru said he had told Eden and President Eisenhower that Egypt's proposal to create a negotiating agency opened the way to a settlement.

"I have in the last few days communicated to Prime Minister Eden and President Eisenhower that the situation after the Menzies mission and the statement by Egypt accepting all international obligations and inviting negotiations opened the way for a settlement," Nehru said.

He added that India appealed to all concerned to accept this situation and seek the "path of peace" and that he hoped his appeal would "not be in vain."

Australian Prime Minister Robert G. Menzies was the chief of the mission which presented to Egypt a plan, supported by 18 nations, for international operation of the canal. Egypt turned the plan down, and instead proposed the creation of a negotiating agency. The Egyptian offer no concrete plans for consideration.

### Road Official To Leave Post

YREKA — Road Commissioner Orel Lewis agreed on Tuesday to vacate his post to allow the appointment by Siskiyou County supervisors of a man more experienced in administrative matters.

Lewis said he was willing to accept the post of road engineer, which will be subordinate to his present position. Being free of the heavy administrative load will allow him to give more time to the backing of county engineering work.

Supervisors who recently decided the administration of the road department and road engineering is too much work for one man, delegated the interviewing of applicants to county administrator Jess O'Rourke.
