**Undercover Reporter**  
As pictures of the exciting French couture collections reach this country probably the most envied female is the model who so nonchalantly sports thousands of dollars in creative design. How soignée she is. How subtly the new lines emphasize her femininity.

But a special report tells us that how she gets to look this way is not entirely the result of the haute couture styles she wears. A special envoy for The H. W. Gossard Co. did some investigating into the basic shapemaking of the most glamorous girls in the world. Gossard's report found that the top Paris designers are extremely particular about the foundations that go under their creations. No matter how slim the model, she can't do justice to high style unless her figure is molded along the designer's lines.

Some designers—Dior is one—prefer separate bras and girdles for their models. Others, like Lanvin-Castillo, insist on an uninterrupted all-in-one. But they all agree clothes have an innerlining, or their own special petticoats. This is because even the best-fitting slip might mar the dress line with a wrinkle in the wrong place. Even the petite young girls who model Maire Jeann Hurst's teenager styles must wear a light, supple girdle and unboned bra.

Gossard's special undercover reporter notes that while each collection is different, certain trends are common. All designers agree on a softer silhouette, with more costume drapery, softer waists, eased skirts, and for evening wear, the low, low back. Dior's new "magnet line" for instance, calls for a high, rounded bustline, slim waist and more curvaceous hips. For his clothes, high waisted, low cut girdles that control the hips all the way down are recommended.

Other designers still like the modified Empire or Princess style. Patou, for instance, uses bells as wide as Obis on short dinner dresses to call attention to the waist.

Although draping is a feature of his afternoon dresses, Fath still aims for a slim figure with almost boyish hips, but a feminine, high-placed bustline. Midriff and bosom are points of departure for the draperies he likes on his soft jersey dresses. His models wear girdles with a waistline that is indicated but not pronounced. For formal wear, strapless bras should curve gently under the arm, toward a deep decollete in back.

**JAMBALAYA**  
A variation of this Caribbean casserole that will serve six is made by browning in a skillet one pound of diced pork in two tablespoons of olive oil, then adding a pound of diced ham and frying for two more minutes.
