### Peaches' Will In Probate

REDWOOD CITY, Calif. (AP) — The last will and testament of Mrs. Ralph Willson—the Peaches Browning of 30 years ago — has been filed in Superior Court here.

The three paragraph document gave no estimate of the estate value. It directed that all bills be paid and that the entire residue be turned over to Mrs. Willson's mother Mrs. Carolyn M. Heenan of San Carlos.

The four-times-married Peaches attained national prominence when at 15 she married 32-year-old Edward (Daddy) Browning, multi-millionaire New York realtor.

She died at the age of 46 at the New York apartment Aug. 23.

### No Resegregation Of D.C. Schools Set, Probers Say

WASHINGTON (AP) — A House investigation of Washington's integrated schools does not point to re-establishing separate white and Negro schools, one of the investigators said today.

"I know that with the political and other facts as they are, there is no prospect of resegregating the Washington public schools," Rep. John Bell Williams (D-Miss.) told newsmen. "Of course, in Mississippi we will never integrate our schools."

Williams is a member of the special House District of Columbia subcommittee which opened hearings yesterday on Washington school problems, especially the effects of integration.

The subcommittee, predominantly made up of Southerners, heard testimony that scholastic achievement levels have dropped, and sex and other discipline problems increased since white and Negro schools were merged in Washington two years ago.

Some of the witnesses said District of Columbia officials might have done better to bring about integration more slowly. But one

said he thinks they chose the best course.

"Since we have here what appears to be a bad situation and must live with it," Williams said, "it is up to the subcommittee, working with devoted members of the Board of Education, to try to initiate remedial action."

He said such action might include a further development of the "four-track" system now be-

ing used in Washington junior and senior high schools. Under this system, pupils are grouped according to what is determined to be their ability to learn.
