

Klamath Pels In Reno For Football Clash

Nevadas Host KU Grid Club

RENO — The Reno High School Huskies, already holding one lopsided football victory, go after another such win here Saturday afternoon as they play host to the Klamath Union High School Pelicans from Klamath Falls, Ore.

Kickoff time for the non-league game is 2 o'clock, Pacific Daylight Time.

Last week, Reno opened its season with a very impressive 43-7 win over the Lassen High Cougars of Susanville. And Coach Dick Trachok's gridders will be out in force tomorrow afternoon on Foster Field to try and hand the Southern Oregon club the same treatment.

Reno will have good reasons for plucking the feathers from the Pelicans. The two schools have

For the host Huskies, Trachok will have eight returning lettermen in the starting lineup, and four other letter winners from last year on the sidelines. In the Reno starting backfield will be Duane Ford at quarterback, John Wall and Tom Crossett at halfback and Gene Germain at fullback. Ford and Wall are two of Reno's returning lettermen, and will guide the Husky split-T attack.

Up front for Reno will be ends Rod Ashley and Jim Murphy, tackles Alex Kanwetz and John McDowell, guards Bill Daniel and Jack Walther, and center Max

Culp. The weights for the Reno line include Ashley and Murphy at 168 and 184, Kanwetz and McDowell at 215 and 211, Daniel and Walther at 185 and 180, and Culp at 190.
