SEOUL — South Korea's Counterintelligence Corps today announced the capture of two Communist spies and two confederates the night before they were to go to North Korea.

The spies were identified as Kij Dong Shik and Ahn Yung Seig.

The CIC said they lived in South Korea before the Korean War as members of the Labor Party and moved North with the Red when they were pushed back at their initial invasion success. Later, the announcement said, they infiltrated back South and joined the Progressive party, which opposes President Syngman Rhee's Liberal party. A Progressive spokesman said he had never heard of the two men.
