### Five Perish In Blaze

CHICAGO (AP)—Five persons perished and at least five others were injured in a fire which swept a four-story brick tenement building on the near North Side early today.

Scores of persons fled from the building. Several children were dropped from the second floor before firemen arrived at the extralarge blaze. None of the injured were in serious condition.

Deputy Marshal Richard Daly said arson was suspected in the fire. He said the blaze started under the stairs in the basement and spread rapidly up the stairwell. He said the stairway was fully aflame when first firemen arrived.

Killed in the fire were three women, a man and a boy about 6, all Negroes. They were not identified immediately.

### Estes Says GOP On Road 'From Reaction To Ruin'

MARQUETTE, Mich. (AP)—Sen. Estes Kefauver said today the Eisenhower administration is "taking us down the dreary and familiar Republican road which runs from reaction to ruin."

The Democratic vice-presidential candidate described his as a road "of high cost-of-living and high interest rates, of spotty unemployment and lopsided prosperity, of governmental concern with corporate profits rather than human welfare."

In a speech prepared for a luncheon meeting here during a one-day political foray into Michigan, he also contended that "Wall Street has been substituted for Main Street as the hub of the nation."

He said that "the Republicans have fought against extension of Social Security, public housing and public power, a decent school bill, and revision or repeal of the Taft-Hartley Act."

"They have permitted, and even invited, plunder of our natural resources on a scale that would have horrified Theodore Roosevelt," he said.

At another point, he said, "They have stacked the various independent regulatory commissions, which are supposed to be watchdogs of the public welfare, with representatives of the very groups they are supposed to regulate."

He also contended anew that "the future of the Republican party really belongs to Richard Nixon and the reactionaries who have built him up and whose spokesman he is."
