Adali Paper Offers Aid

BLOOMINGTON, Ill. (AP) — The Bloomington Pantagraph, which refused to endorse Adlai Stevenson in 1952, announced Sunday it will support him for President this year.

Stevenson, the Democratic nominee, and his sister, Mrs. Ernest Ives of Southern Pines, N. C., between them own a minority of the newspaper's stock which amounts to almost 50 per cent of it.

The Pantagraph said it could not support Stevenson in 1952 because he was sponsored by an entrenched Truman administration, but said "today he is a free man."

The newspaper announced its stand in an editorial in Sunday editions.

"He (Stevenson) has earned the nomination, through his own efforts and his still growing ability. He is in no way obligated to the New Deal, the Fair Deal, or any other deal," the editorial stated.

The Pantagraph, which serves a strongly Republican area in central Illinois, is committed to an independent political policy.

Majority interest in the newspaper is held by three of Stevenson's cousins. One of them, Loring Merwin, is publisher.

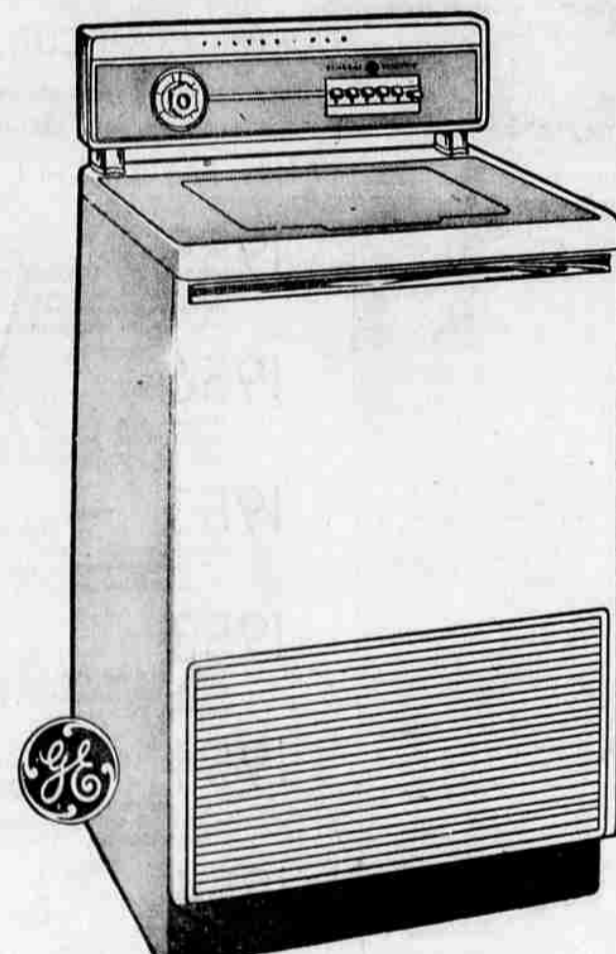

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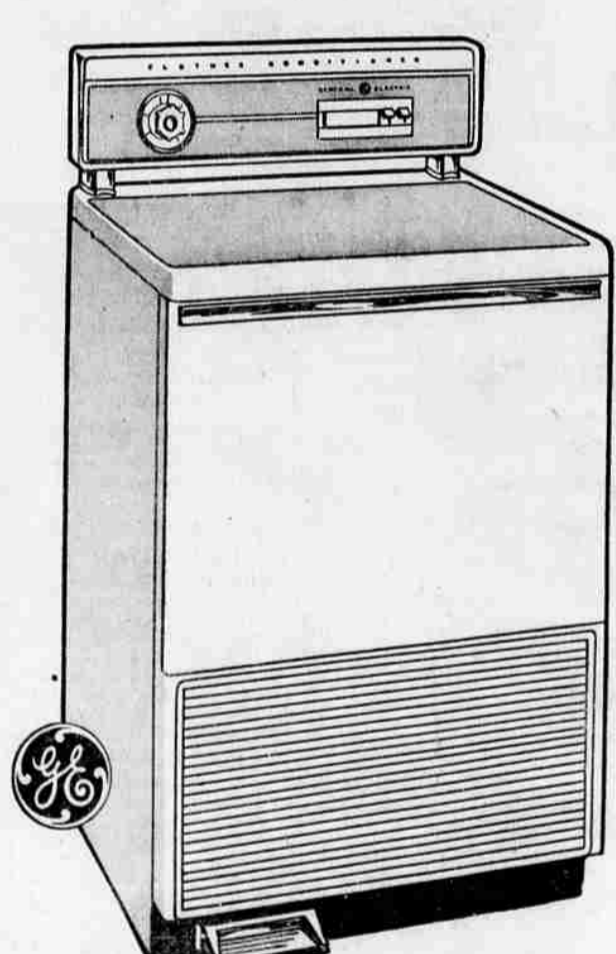
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
