Police Probe Knife Attack

One man was in jail and another under treatment for a stab wound following a knifing affray at a South Sixth Street drive-in cafe Saturday night.

Jack Parker, 19, of Keno, told City Policemen Dennis Lilly and Lionel Olsen that he and a girl friend were seated in an automobile in front of the cafe when three men approached. One of the men, according to Parker, ordered the girl to get out of the car and be "inspected."

Parker leaped from the car and a fight ensued. Parker was stabbed in the back. He was taken to Klamath Valley Hospital for treatment. Hospital officials said the wound was superficial.

Later police arrested Isidore Gutierrez, 18-year-old Bonanza farm worker. They said he was involved in the attack on Parker but did not wield the knife. The two other men are still sought.
