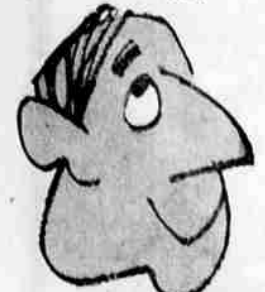
BIRTHDAYS HONORED
