

# Air Power Show Slated

Klamath Falls Mayor Paul Landry and Max Wauchope, city editor of the Herald and News, were scheduled to leave by U. S. Air Force aircraft Thursday morning from Klamath Falls to attend an air power demonstration at Eglin Air Force Base, Florida as guests of the Air Force.

This air power demonstration is staged by the Air Force every year to demonstrate the latest tactics and weapons. Members of Congress, military representatives from all over the world, and correspondents from the various press media are invited each year. The demonstration will take place on Sunday.

On the return trip from Eglin, Mayor Landry and Wauchope will stop at Yuma Air Force Base, Arizona to see a rocket shooting meet which will be underway at that Air Force base. This is also an annual event.

The two Klamath Falls men will be flown via Air Force aircraft both ways on the trip to and from Florida. They will join other civic officials and press representatives from the West Coast at Hamilton Air Force Base, California for the flight to Florida and return.

# Ancient Study To Be Shown

The Klamath County Museum will have the distribution locally of Dr. Luther Cressman's archaeological study of the Klamath Basin upon its appearance in print sometime next month. Dr. Cressman, head of the Department of Anthropology, University of Oregon and prominent authority on early man in America, spent several summers exploring native camp and burial sites in this area. The results of his investigations are disclosed in the forthcoming volume, Klamath Prehistory, published by the American Philosophical Society, Philadelphia. # Border Patrol Stages Raids

Five border patrol inspectors from Blaine, Washington, staged a series of raids on work camps in Klamath County Tuesday night and arrested 14 Mexican wetbacks and four Canadians who are alleged to have entered the United States illegally.

B. P. Quigley, inspector in charge, said 15 Mexican wetbacks were also rounded up in raids at Vale and Ontario a week ago.

The border jumpers picked up here will be taken to Portland. The Mexicans will then be sent by plane to the southern border. The Canadians will be taken to Blaine.
