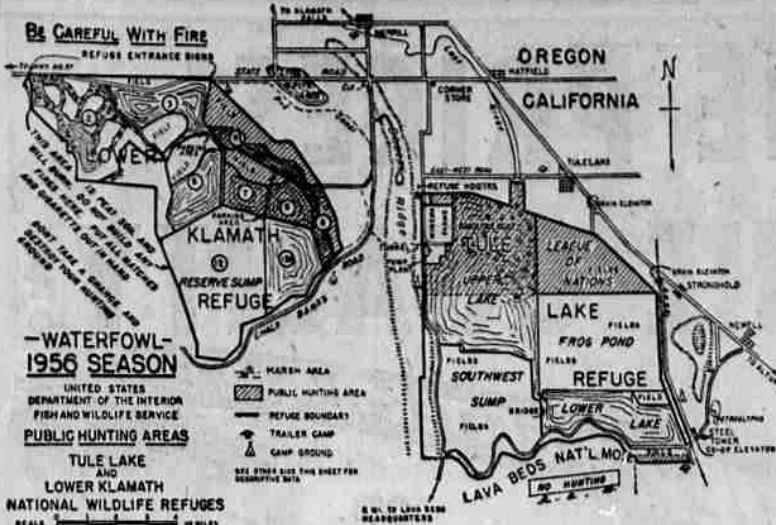




**THE PUBLIC HUNTING AREAS** within the Tulelake and Lower Klamath National Wildlife Refuges are shown on the above map. Hunters are reminded that while this area has the same season as Oregon a California license is required. California shooting hours are observed and the coot season does not open until November 17. This season then extends until March 1. Bag and possession limit on ducks is 10 per day provided that such limits contain not less than three pintails or widgeons or three in the aggregate of both, and not more than one wood duck or one hooded merganser. The limit on geese is six per day and six in possession provided that not more than three are of the dark variety. All hunters over the age of 16 must possess a signed migratory waterfowl stamp.
