20-30 Prexies To Meet Here

Presidents of 20-30 Clubs in 20-30 International's Northwest District will meet in Klamath Falls Sunday, October 14, for a conference on club management and community improvement plans.

The Council of Presidents meeting of this largest of young men's service clubs will be conducted by District Governor John D. Watkins of Medford. Scheduled to participate in the conference will be 20-30 Clubs of Oregon, Washington and Northern California.

Theme of the meeting is plans for expansion of the organization in the northwest. Watkins announced that the goal of the district is the establishment of 20-30 Clubs in all cities in Oregon with 5,000 or more population.

In pointing out the potentialities of Oregon for development, Watkins compared this state's seven chapters with more than 170 in California.

Among the projects to be discussed Sunday will be the 20-30 International Rheumatic Fever Foundation, which annually contributes funds to the support of five medical research institutions in the United States.

Host president for the meeting is Lyle R. Steers, 4627 Boardman, Klamath Falls.

Nursing Course Openings Told

There is room for three more enrollments in the Licensed Practical Nursing course at Oregon Technical Institute, Director W. D. Purvine said this week.

The course includes eight weeks of pre-clinical training on the Oregon Tech campus and 40 - hour weeks in a local hospital in actual clinical practice.

Any girl who is a high school graduate or who can take and pass a high school equivalency test, given at the high school, is eligible to enroll. Juvenile Home Plans Outlined

YREKA — Construction and financing of a \$56,640 juvenile home for Siskiyou County was outlined by Hahn, Wise and Associates, planning consultants, in a report to the Siskiyou Planning Commission last week.

Use of land adjacent to the county hospital and already owned by the county was recommended. Financing by borrowing from the Employees Retirement fund was the suggestion of the planners.

The building recommended would be designed for both dependent and delinquent children, with complete facilities for up to 23 dependent children and a six cell maximum security unit.

An opportunity for consideration of the plan will be given the members of the planning commission, the probation officer and the county administrator before possible action on the report at the November planning commission meeting.

In other action of the group, a petition from residents in the area surrounding Mount Shasta was received, the general boundary of the proposed city of Happy Camp was approved, and the purchase of a 45 acre dump area near Happy Camp was approved.
