Purvine Clarifies OTI Player Status

Correcting the erroneous impression created by a story in Friday evening's Herald and News, W. D. Purvine, director of Oregon Tech, stated emphatically that the four

boys suspended by Coach Rex Hunsaker from the Owl football team were not expelled from Oregon Tech.

Three of the boys, Purvine said, have been given "honorable withdrawal slips" at their request and are returning to their homes in Pennsylvania.

The fourth, Tom Wylie, a first year engineering technology student, has decided to remain on the campus and continue his studies at Oregon Tech.

The four boys, 1956 graduates of the McKeesport, Pennsylvania, high school, entered Oregon Tech as first year students last month. After signing up for the Owl football team, Hunsaker reported that they were not attending football practice regularly and because of this infringement of his rules, he suspended them from the team just before the Oregon Tech team left for Saturday's game with Eastern Oregon College of Education.

The impression created that the boys were expelled from school for disciplinary reasons is entirely unfounded on fact," Purvine declared. "The three who withdrew, Richard Perlick, Tommy Carlon and Carl Pastore, did so voluntarily. Tom Wylie, who elected to remain in is in good standing so far as the school is concerned."

The triumph was No. 3 in the league for the Bobcats, who've won five this season. It was C. State's first loss in three league games.
