Colorado Dam Projects Start

SALT LAKE CITY (AP)—Bureau of Reclamation officials waited at two remote spots today for the signal from President Eisenhower that starts construction of the gigantic Upper Colorado River project.

Arrangements were made for the President to touch a button in the White House in Washington. It was to set off an electrical impulse which would travel along telephone lines and on radio circuits to Glen Canyon, in northern Arizona, and Flaming Gorge, in northern Utah.

There explosives were ready to begin, at the President's signal, construction work on two of the units which make up the 760-million-dollar project, largest reclamation undertaking ever authorized by Congress at a single time.

Glen Canyon, 700 feet high, and Flaming Gorge, 500 feet high, will be two of the four storage and power-producing dams of the Upper Colorado project. Both will be of concrete.

Glen Canyon, on the Colorado River in Arizona, just south of the Utah border, will produce 800,000 kilowatts of power, about two thirds the capacity of Hoover Dam also on the Colorado. Flaming Gorge, on the Green River, a Colorado tributary, will produce 85,000 kilowatts. It is located in Utah, just south of the Wyoming border.

The Upper Colorado project also includes distribution units which will carry water to land in the area for irrigation purposes. Altogether the project embraces an area of about 110,000 square miles.

Construction of Glen Canyon and Flaming Gorge dams is expected to take about six years. Development of other units will take even longer.

Len Gray will present his

trained Arabian stallion and two-gun Smokey, the cowboy bear. Tippy and Cobina, chimpanzees of widespread fame will compete for laughs.

Holt emphasized that the \$1 admission for adults and the 25 cents for children includes admission to everything held in conjunction with the nation's most diversified big stock show.

Workmen have been busy this week at the Pacific International preparing for this year's presentation. Carpenters, painters, electricians and artisans of every sort are transforming the 11 acre pavilion into an unbelievably beautiful setting for the big show.

Some 9,000 yards of plastic have been used to form a blue ceiling throughout the show areas. An autumn touch is furnished by vine maple which is used profusely throughout the building.

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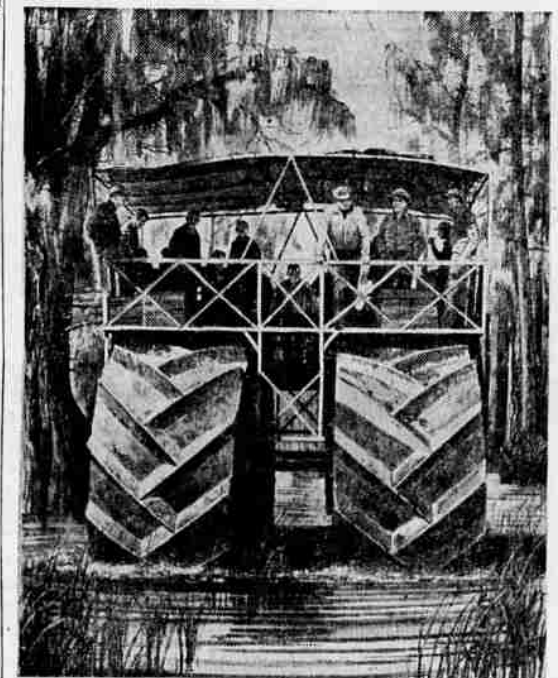


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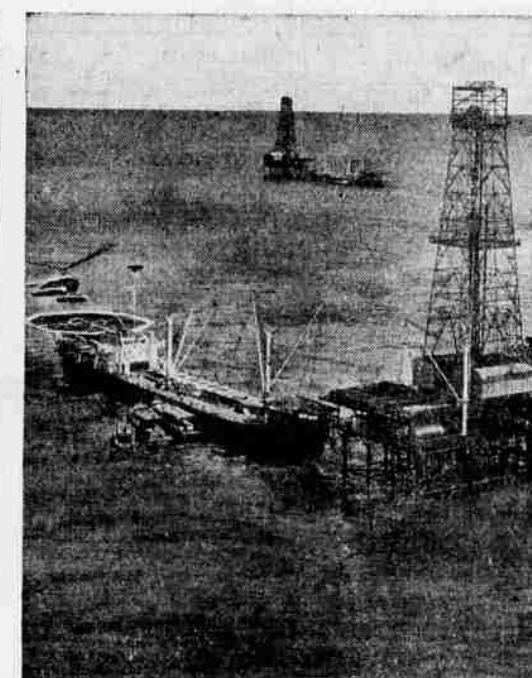

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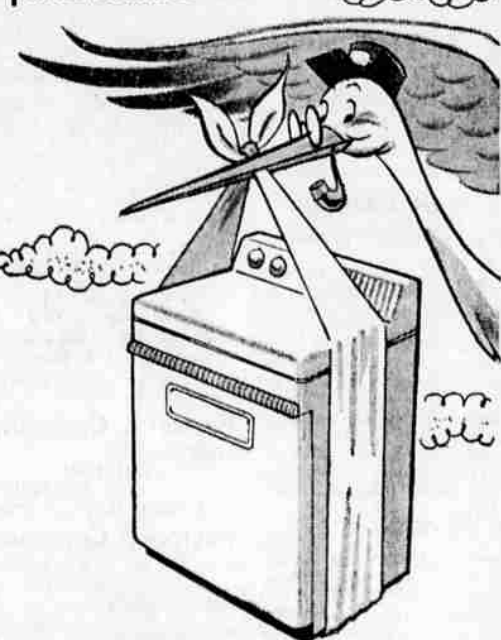


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
