

Viaduct Opening Now Advanced To June 1, 1957

The opening date of the new South Sixth Street viaduct has been advanced to June 1, 1957, announced Cliff Sanders of the city engineer's office at the regular city council meeting Monday night in the city hall.

Advancement of the opening date has been made necessary due to the shortage of steel girders needed to complete the center span of the viaduct, Sanders reported. About one-third of the steel is now on hand but even if all the steel had been delivered, completion of the viaduct would probably have to be delayed until next spring due to the closeness of winter weather, Sanders stated.

The viaduct is being constructed by Tom Lillebo, Reedsport, Oregon contractor, for the Oregon State Highway Department which supplied the funds for the structure.

CLARIFICATION

The city council also authorized the clarification of the wording of the contract for the lease of the Klamath Falls Municipal Airport with the U.S. Air Force. The Western Air Defense Force headquarters at Hamilton Air Force Base, California requested that the clarification be made.

The contract will be so worded that it is specified that the Air Force will provide all the electrical power for the lighting of all the runways at the airport. The Air Force will be responsible for the maintenance of the main runway (which runs 140-320 degrees and is 10,700 feet long) and the city of Klamath Falls will have the responsibility of maintaining the other two runways of the airport. The Air Force will provide for snow removal from all the runways at no expense to the city.

The third and final reading of an ordinance providing for the third attempt to annex the Sunnyland addition to Klamath Falls was heard by the council.

IN ABEYANCE

This ordinance must now lie in abeyance for 30 days to provide the time for any residents of the city of Klamath Falls who oppose the annexation plan to prepare a referendum against it. If the ordinance is not referred at the end of 30 days, then the council passes another ordinance setting up a special election. At this election, all the registered voters of the area may indicate approval or disapproval of the annexation plan. The new election was made necessary because the ballot title of the June 26 election was in error.

Another annexation ordinance was read for the third and final time at Monday night's meeting.

This provides for the annexation of 57 acres in the Washburn Way, South Sixth Street area near the Tower Theater.

This ordinance must also be held in abeyance for 30 days to allow

time for any referendum action against it. At the end of the 30 days, the council can then pass another ordinance admitting the tract into the city. An election is not necessary because 100 per cent

of the property owners of the area have approved the annexation plan by petition.

The council accepted the bid of Asphalt Paving Co. for the paving of Donald, Fulton and Siskiyou

streets. The bid was for \$18,506.22 city engineers office estimated the cost of the project at \$16,466.18.
